The Melbourne Cup Day for 2002 falls on Tuesday 5 November.


In accordance with Section 9(a) of the **Public Holidays Act 1993** a full day bank holiday will apply throughout the municipal district on 5 November 2002.

The general purport of the Principal Local Law included a specification of the laws which governed the election of the Lord Mayor, the

general order of business, the use of the common seal and penalties for non-compliance. It also applied the terms of the Council's Meeting Procedures Code to the conduct of meetings.

The general purport of the Local Law is to delete from the Principal Local Law provisions relating to the election of the Lord Mayor which are inconsistent with those specified in the **City of Melbourne Act 2001**.

Any person affected by the proposed Local Law may make a submission relating to the proposed Local Law under Section 223 of the **Local Government Act 1989**. Any person who has made a written submission is entitled to appear in person, or by a person acting on his or her behalf, before a meeting of the Committee to be held at 2.30 pm, Friday 1 February 2002 at the Melbourne Town Hall.

PROPOSAL TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NO. 6 STREETS AND ROADS – PRIVATE BUILDING WORKS INSPECTIONS

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 119(2) of the **Local Government Act 1989** that the Council of the Mornington Peninsula Shire proposes to amend Local Law No. 6 – Streets and Roads by inserting a new part titled – Private Building Works Inspections. The purpose of this amendment is to allow for the protection of Council assets through the introduction of Private Building Works Inspections by Council Officers and the adoption of a fee to cover the cost of such inspections.

The general purport of this amendment is as follows:

- provides for an Authorised Officer to undertake inspections, prior to the commencement and following the completion of any private building works, to determine whether any damage has occurred to Council assets as a direct result of the building works undertaken;
- ensures that any person responsible for damaging Council assets shall bear the cost of repairs or maintenance of such assets; and

The Amendment will rezone the southern portion of the Epping Plaza land through to Childs Road, which is presently undeveloped, to the Business 1 Zone; and apply a Development Plan Overlay with an accompanying Schedule 12 to the whole of the Epping Plaza land.




