ROAD DECLARATIONS AND DEDICATIONS

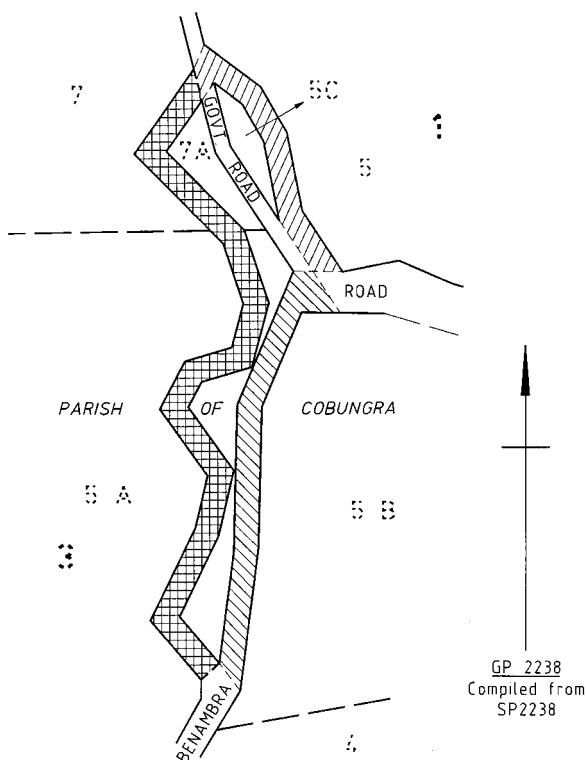
