Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

Marine Safety Victoria, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby gives notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that for the following periods

- (a) the operation of vessels, excluding those vessels involved with the event and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on the waters and for the periods as detailed below
- (b) the vessels involved in activities in the designated Event Area A listed in this Notice, excluding slalom waterskiing, wake-boarding activities and vessels operating as rescue and event support craft, are excluded from Clauses 2(c), 3(a) & 3(b), 18 and 19(b) and 19(d) of Notice No.1 made under s.15(2) of the Marine Act 1988 for the periods detailed below.

Event Area A - being the waters of Victoria Harbour within a rectangular area bounded on the:

- northern boundary by North Wharf
- western boundary by an imaginary line commencing from the eastern end of berth 19, North Wharf heading in approximately a south easterly direction to a floating buoy placed approximately 150m south west of the south-lateral marker located at the western end of Central Wharf
- eastern boundary by the eastern edge of the floating pontoons that make up the marina adjacent to number 16 berth, North Wharf and an imaginary line extending from the south eastern most corner of the floating pontoons that make up the marina to a point midway along berth 14 Central Wharf
- southern boundary by the Northern side of Central Wharf and a prolongation to a floating buoy placed approximately 150m south west of the south-lateral marker located at the western end of Central Wharf.
