## VICTORIAN CASINO AND GAMING AUTHORITY

Notice of Specified Areas in the Melbourne Casino

By this notice the Victorian Casino and Gaming Authority specifies the areas shown in the attached Schedule for the purposes of s62AB(4), s62AC(2) and s81AAB(2) of the Casino Control Act 1991.

It is a condition of this notice that electronic gaming machines located in specified areas may only operate in a mode where spin rate, bet limit, autoplay and note acceptors are unrestricted if that gaming machine may only be played in that mode by means of a card, Personal Identification Number (PIN) or similar technology which requires the player to nominate limits on time and net loss before play can commence.

This notice operates with effect from 1 January 2003.
