Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001

ORDER UNDER SECTION 25

Administration and Enforcement of **Building Act 1993**

In accordance with Section 25 of the **Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001**, I Mary Delahunty as the Minister for the time being administering the **Building Act 1993** hereby declare by this order that the administration and enforcement of the **Building Act 1993** and the regulations made under that Act in relation to the Commonwealth Games project known as the "Melbourne Cricket Ground Redevelopment Project" being a Commonwealth Games Project as defined in the **Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001** is to be carried out by Mr Shane Leonard of Philip Chun and Associates Pty Ltd, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The Building Commission may at its discretion conduct random audits to examine the administration and enforcement of the **Building Act 1993** and the Building Regulations 1994 carried out by Mr Leonard which may include carrying out site inspections; and
- 2) Mr Leonard must provide a monthly report to the Building Commission which must include copies of all building permits issued and determinations under the Building Code of Australia 1996 (BCA) that an alternative solution complies with a performance requirement including details of how that compliance with the BCA has been achieved.
