1. **Title**  
This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 183) 2002.
2. **Authorising provision**  
This Order is made under section 3 of the **Administrative Arrangements Act 1983**.
3. **Commencement**  
This Order takes effect on 5 December 2002.
4. **Definitions**  
In this Order—  
“**Body**” means Minister, Department or officer;  
“**instrument**” includes contract and agreement;  
“**Old Body**” means a Body specified in Column 1 of an item in the Schedule;  
“**New Body**” means a Body specified in Column 3 of an item in the Schedule;  
“**Schedule**” means Schedule to this Order;  
“**transaction**” includes—
  - (a) agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement; and
  - (b) action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding; and
  - (c) assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property; and
  - (d) loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money; and
  - (e) approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, order, permit, requirement or other authority; and
  - (f) notice; and
  - (g) any other act, entitlement or liability at law.
5. **Construction of references**
  - (1) In respect of each item in the Schedule to the Administrative Arrangements Order (182) 2002, a reference to a New Body (within the meaning of that Order) specified in Column 3 of an item in that Schedule—
    - (a) in a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of that Schedule; or
    - (b) in a statutory instrument or other instrument made under an Act specified in Column 2 of that Schedule; or

- (c) in respect of any other matter or thing done under a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of that Schedule—

is deemed to be a reference to the Old Body (within the meaning of that Order) specified in Column 1 of that item in that Schedule.

Note: The effect of this sub-clause is to reverse the administrative changes made by the Administrative Arrangements Order (182) 2002. Sub-clause (2) makes fresh administrative changes.

- (2) In respect of each item in the Schedule, a reference to an Old Body (including a reference that is a reference to an Old Body because of sub-clause (1))—

- (a) in a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or
- (b) in a statutory instrument or other instrument made under an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or
- (c) in respect of any other matter or thing done under a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule—

is deemed to be a reference to the New Body.

**6. Saving of existing transactions**

If a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body before this Order takes effect—

- (a) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction; and
- (b) the transaction shall continue and may be completed in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been continued and may have been completed in relation to the Old Body if this Order had not been made.
