Planning and Environment Act 1987 HUME PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment

Amendment C32

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C32 to the Hume Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment:

- rezones a narrow section of land either side of the existing Cooper Street, Somerton, between the Merri Creek and the Hume Highway from the existing zone to a Road Zone Category 1;
- deletes the narrow section of Public Acquisition Overlay either side of the existing Cooper Street between the Merri Creek and the Hume Highway, Somerton; and
- inserts a site specific clause into Schedule 2 of the Environment Significance Overlay to enable the works for the Cooper Street widening to occur without further planning approval.

Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment C34

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C34 to the Hume Planning Scheme. The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment:

- removes a portion of the existing Public Acquisition Overlay at Shannon Rise Estate, Greenvale. The Overlay was required by the Roads Corporation (VicRoads) for a proposed arterial road, otherwise known as the E14 expressway; and
- realigns the Public Acquisition Overlay further to the east, as previously approved under the former Hume Planning Scheme.

Amendment C35

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C35 to the Hume Planning Scheme.

WHITTLESEA PLANNING SCHEME

Notice of Approval of Amendment

Amendment C33

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C33 to the Whittlesea Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment:

- rezones a narrow strip of land up to 10 metres wide either side of the existing Cooper Street, Epping between the Merri Creek and Yale Drive from the existing zone to a Road Zone Category 1;
- deletes the narrow strip of Public Acquisition Overlay up to 10 metres wide either side of the existing Cooper Street between the Merri Creek and Yale Drive; and
- inserts site specific clauses into Schedule 3 of the Environment Significance Overlay and the Schedules to the Rural Floodway Overlay and the Land Subject to Inundation Overlays to enable the works for the Cooper Street widening to occur without further planning permit.
