I, John Landy, Governor of Victoria, declare that I have today assented in Her Majesty's name to the following Bills:

No. 103/2003 Animals Legislation (Animal Welfare) Act 2003

 (1) This Part and sections 4, 6, 7, 8, 24, 29, 30(1) and (3), 34, 35, 36, 42, 43, 44(2) and (3), 45 to 58, 60 and 62 to 67 come into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

- (2) Subject to sub-section (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (3) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 1 December 2005, it comes into operation on that day.

No. 104/2003 Crimes (Money Laundering) Act 2003

- Subject to sub-section (3), this Act (except section 7) comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
- (2) Section 7 comes into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
- (3) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 1 January 2004, it comes into operation on that day.

No. 105/2003 Crimes (Stalking) Act 2003

This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

No. 106/2003 Fair Trading (Further Amendment) Act 2003

- This Part and sections 4, 5, 6, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 24, 25, 27, 28 and 29 come into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) Section 23 is deemed to have come into operation on 27 May 2003.
- (3) Subject to sub-section (4), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- SPECIAL

(4) If a provision referred to in sub-section (3) does not come into operation before 31 December 2004, it comes into operation on that day.

No. 107/2003 Firearms (Amendment) Act 2003

- Sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 come into operation on the day on which section 10 of the Firearms (Trafficking and Handgun Control) Act 2003 comes into operation.
- (2) The remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

No. 108/2003 Fisheries (Further Amendment) Act 2003

- (1) This Act (other than sections 5, 29(3), 30, 31, 44 and 46) comes into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) Subject to sub-section (3) and (4), sections 5 and 44 come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (3) If section 5 does not come into operation before 1 January 2005, it comes into operation on that day.
- (4) If section 44 does not come into operation before 1 April 2004, it comes into operation on that day.
- (5) Sections 31 and 46 come into operation on 1 April 2004.
- (6) Sections 29(3) and 30 come into operation on 31 December 2004.

No. 109/2003 Local Government

(Democratic Reform) Act 2003

(1) This Part comes into operation on the day after the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

- (2) Part 5 comes into operation on 1 February 2004.
- (3) Subject to sub-section (4), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (4) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 31 December 2004, it comes into operation on that day.

No. 110/2003 Parliamentary Committees Act 2003

This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

No. 111/2003 Road Safety (Drug Driving) Act 2003

- Subject to sub-section (2), this Act (except section 23) comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (2) If a provision of this Act (other than section 23) does not come into operation before 1 December 2004, it comes into operation on that day.
- (3) Section 23 comes into operation on 1 July 2005.
- No. 112/2003 Shop Trading Reform (Simplification) Act 2003 This Act comes into operation

on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

No. 113/2003 State Taxation (Further Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2003

- This Act (other than Part 2 and Division 1 of Part 5) comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) Part 2 (other than section 3) and Division 1 of Part 5 come into operation on 1 January 2004.
- (3) Section 3 is deemed to have come into operation on 16 August 2003.

Local Government (Democratic Reform) Act 2003

PROCLAMATION OF COMMENCEMENT

I, John Landy, Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council and under section 2(3) of the Local Government (Democratic Reform) Act 2003 —

- (a) fix 10 December 2003 as the day on which Part 2, sections 15 to 18, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 32, 33, 35(1), 36, 37, 40, 41, 42, 46, 47 to 51, 52(1), 52(2), 52(4), 52(5), 54, 55, 56, 61, 64 to 69, 78, 79, 84 to 88, 92, 93, 95(1), 95(2), 96, 99, 102, 103 and 104 of that Act come into operation;
- (b) fix 7 January 2004 as the day on which sections 34 and 35(2) of that Act come into operation; and
- (c) fix 13 February 2004 as the day on which sections 80, 82 and 83 of that Act come into operation.
