Country Fire Authority Act 1958

DECLARATION OF FIRE DANGER PERIOD

In pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the **Country Fire Authority Act 1958**, I, Neil Graeme Bibby, Chief Executive Officer of the Country Fire Authority, after consultation with the Secretary to the Department of Sustainability and Environment, hereby declare the following periods to be the Fire Danger Period in the municipal districts of the municipalities or parts of municipalities specified, commencing on the dates shown and, unless varied by subsequent declaration, ending at 0100 hours on 1 May 2004.

To commence from 0100 hours on 15 December 2003: City of Manningham (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), Shire of Nillumbik (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), City of Banyule (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), Hume City Council (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), Macedon Ranges Shire Council, Melton Shire Council, City of Whittlesea (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), Wyndham City Council (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District).

To commence from 0100 hours on 22 December 2003: Glenelg Shire Council, West Wimmera Shire Council (remainder), Southern Grampians Shire Council (part): that part west of the line described by the following— Commencing on the Chetwynd–Nareen Road following a southerly direction to a point two kilometres north of the Wando Vale North Road then easterly to Saw Pit Gully Road and Carrols Road. Then south-easterly to the Wannon River. Following the Wannon River to Murndale Road then southerly following the Condah–Coleraine Road to McMilans Road. Then easterly to the Henty Highway then north to Lens Road. Easterly to the Wallacedale–Hamilton Road to Branxholme–Byaduck Road to Kinghorn Road then following in a south-westerly direction to a point south of Ryans Road where the Glenelg,

Moyne and Southern Grampians Shires meet. Shire of Yarra Ranges (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), City of Maroondah (those portions not included in the Metropolitan Fire District), City of Knox.
