Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

Marine Safety Victoria, on the recommendation of Parks Victoria, hereby gives notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) the operation of vessels is prohibited on the Yarra River and Victoria Harbour within the areas detailed in Table 3 and at the times as specified in Table 1 excluding those vessels listed in Table 2;
- (b) the vessels involved with the events listed in this Notice are excluded from Clauses 3(a) & 3(b) of Notice No.1 made under s.15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the times detailed in Table 1;
- (c) the vessels involved with the 2003 Melbourne Masters and Moomba Ski Show, on the dates and times listed in Table 1 of this Notice are excluded from Clauses 18 and 19(b) and 19(d) of Notice No.1 made under s.15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the periods detailed below, excluding –
 - (i) vessels and persons participating in slalom, ski jump and wakeboarding events and training; and
 - (ii) work and rescue vessels
- (d) the waters of zone H of the Yarra River, as described in Table 3, are a no wash zone during times specified in Table 1.

Table 3: River Closure Zones for 2003 Melbourne Moomba Waterfest

Area A	The whole of the Yarra River from a line crossing the river at the eastern most point of the Victorian Rowing Association Landing upstream to Swan Street Bridge
Area B	The whole of the Yarra River from a line crossing the river at the eastern most point of the Victorian Rowing Association Landing upstream to a line crossing the river at a point 50m west of Morell Bridge (Anderson Street)
Area C	The whole of the Yarra River from a line crossing the river at a point 50 metres east of the fireworks barge moored at Birrarung Marr upstream to the Swan Street Bridge
Area D	The whole of the Yarra River from a line crossing the river at the eastern most point of Berth 5 of Princess Wharf to a line crossing the river at the Eastern most point of the Victorian Rowing Association Landing
Area E	The whole Yarra River from a line crossing the river at the western most point of Henley Landing to the upstream side of the pedestrian bridge at Southgate
Area F	The whole of the Yarra River between Kings Bridge and Spencer Street Bridge
Area G	The southern arm of Victoria Harbour within an area bounded on the north by an imaginary line extending from the north west corner of Central Pier in a south westerly direction to the western end of berth 3 on North Wharf west by the northern side of berths 3 and 4 of North Wharf south by the northern side of berth 5 of North Wharf east by an imaginary line extending at right angles from berth 5 to the north western corner of Central Pier
Area H	The whole of the Yarra River from Spencer Street Bridge to a line crossing the river 50m upstream of the fireworks barge moored at Birrarung Marr.
