ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA WITHIN VICTORIA AROUND BAROOGA (NSW) FOR THE CONTROL OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

1. **Objective**

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area within Victoria for the control of Queensland fruit fly around Barooga (NSW) and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

2. **Authorising provisions**

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. **Definition**

In this Order –

- (a) “**Act**” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**;
- (b) “**Plant Health Certificate**” has the same meaning as in the Act;
- (c) “**Plant Health Declaration**” has the same meaning as in the Act;
- (d) “**Queensland fruit fly**” means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggart); and
- (e) “**Regulations**” mean the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

4. **Restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly**

The restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly is declared to be the area described in Schedule 1.

5. **Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements**

- (1) The removal from the restricted area into any part of Victoria of any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland fruit fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations is prohibited unless the fruit or vegetable is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate of Plant Health Declaration and in the case of fruit for treatment, packing or processing outside the restricted area, is accompanied by a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.
- (2) Any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland fruit fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations, must not be transported from areas free of Queensland fruit fly through the restricted area except in accordance with the conditions of a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.

Schedule 1

The area of land bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the Murray Valley Highway and Grinter Road, then in a southerly direction along Grinter Road to the intersection of Grinter Road and Powerline Road, then in a westerly direction along Powerline Road to the intersection of Powerline Road and Youarang Road, then in a southerly direction along Youarang Road to the intersection of Youarang Road and Cassidy Road, then in a westerly direction along Cassidy Road to the intersection of Cassidy Road and Barnes Road, then in a southerly direction along Barnes Road to the intersection of Barnes Road and Fields Road, then in a westerly direction along Fields Road to the intersection of Fields Road and McPherson Road, then in a northerly direction along McPherson Road to the intersection of McPherson Road and Ross Road, then in a westerly direction along Ross Road to the intersection of Ross Road and Larissa Road, then in a northerly direction along Larissa Road to the intersection of Larissa Road and Sandmount Road, then in a westerly direction along Sandmount Road to the intersection of Sandmount Road and Kokoda Road, then in a northerly direction along Kokoda Road to the intersection of Kokoda Road and Montgomery Road, then in a westerly direction along Montgomery Road to the intersection of Montgomery Road and Stokes Road, then in a northerly direction along Stokes Road to the intersection of Stokes Road and Myree–Koonoomoo Road, then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the intersection of Green Road and Goulburn Valley Highway, then in a northerly direction along Goulburn Valley Highway until it intersects with the Murray River, then in a south-easterly direction along the Murray River to where a straight line in a northerly direction from the end of Grinter Road intersects with the Murray River.
