Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995

ORDER PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING THE MOVEMENT AND HANDLING OF PLANTS AND PLANT PARTS OF GRAMINEAE, TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF THE EXOTIC DISEASE, WHEAT STREAK MOSAIC DISEASE

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under Sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring restricted areas for the control of a disease suspected to be wheat streak mosaic disease and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

1. Objective

The objective of this Order is to prohibit subject to conditions or restrict the movement of plants and plant parts of Gramineae to prevent the introduction or spread of the exotic disease wheat streak mosaic disease caused by wheat streak mosaic virus.

2. Authorising provision

This Order is made under Sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. Duration of Order

This Order continues for such period that wheat streak mosaic disease is declared under Section 5 or 5A of the Act to be an exotic disease, but shall not continue for a period greater than 12 months.

4. Definitions

In this Order —

- (a) “Act” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**; and
- (b) “Manager Plant Standards” means the person for the time being occupying or acting in the position of Manager Plant Standards in the Department of Primary Industries;
- (c) “Inspector” means an officer authorised under the Act; and
- (d) “Plant material” means plants and plant parts of the Gramineae family.

5. Restricted areas for the control of wheat streak mosaic disease

The restricted area for the control of wheat streak mosaic disease is declared to be the area described in Schedule 1.

6. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements

- (1) A person must not remove from the restricted area:
 - (a) any plant material that has been grown in the restricted area; or
 - (b) any packages used to contain any plant material grown in the restricted area; or
 - (c) any agricultural equipment used to harvest or handle plant material grown in the restricted area;unless the movement complies with the conditions of a permit issued by an inspector under Section 21 of the Act.

- (2) Plant material grown within the restricted area or part of the restricted area must be tested, treated or otherwise disposed of in a manner approved by an inspector.
- (3) Agricultural equipment used to harvest or handle plant material within the restricted area must be treated in a manner approved by an inspector.
- (4) Plant material grown within the restricted area or part of the restricted area must be handled and stored separately from material sourced from other parts of the restricted area or from other areas outside the restricted area, clearly identified at all times and held under security at a premises approved by an inspector.
- (5) A person must not plant or sow any plant material within the restricted area unless approved by an inspector.

Schedule 1

The area of land within a zone commencing at a north west point 2 32 670 Easting, 59 58 232 Northing, then in a straight line in an easterly direction to the north east point 2 33 055 Easting, 59 58 240 Northing, then in a straight line in a southerly direction to the south east point 2 32 677 Easting, 59 58 126 Northing, then in a westerly direction to the south west point 2 33 057 Easting, 59 58 133 Northing, then in a northerly direction to the north west point.
