No. 51/2003 This Act commences on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

- No. 52/2003 (1) This Act (except the provisions referred to in sub-section (2)) comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
 - (2) The following provisions come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed –.
 - (a) paragraphs (d) and (e) of the definition of "Commonwealth body or person" in section 3(1);
 - (b) section 15;
 - (c) Division 3 of Part 2;
 - (d) Section 44(1)(b);
 - (e) Items 11 and 14 of Schedule 1.

No. 53/2003 (1) This Part comes into operation on a day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

- (2) Sections 9 and 10 come into operation on the day that is the third anniversary of the day on which section 5 comes into operation.
- (3) Sections 20 and 21 come into operation on the day that is the third anniversary of the day on which section 14 comes into operation.
- (4) Subject to sub-section (5), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
- (5) If a provision referred to in sub-section (4) does not come into operation before 1 January 2004, it comes into operation on that day.
- No. 54/2003 This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- No. 55/2003 (1) Subject to sub-section (2), this Act (except section 5) comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
 - (2) If this Act (except section 5) does not come into operation before 1 July 2004, it comes into operation on that day.
 - (3) Section 5 comes into operation on the second anniversary of the day that this Act (except that section) comes into operation.
- No. 56/2003 This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- No. 57/2003 This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- No. 58/2003 (1) This Act (exception sections 4, 6, 13(2), 14, 16, 17 and 20) comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
 - (2) Sections 6, 13(2), 14 and 17 are deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2001.
 - (3) Section 4 is deemed to have come into operation on 8 February 2003.
 - (4) Section 20(1) and (2) is deemed to have come into operation on 7 May 2003.
 - (5) Section 16 comes into operation on 1 July 2003.
 - (6) Section 20(3) comes into operation on 1 January 2004.
- No. 59/2003 (1) Subject to sub-section (2), this Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
 - (2) If this Act does not come into operation on or before 1 July 2004, it comes into operation on that day.
- No. 60/2003 (1) This Act (except sections 3, 17 and 18) is deemed to have come into operation on 21 May 2003.
 - (2) Sections 3, 17 and 18 come into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
