Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001 COMMONWEALTH GAMES VENUE ORDER


In accordance with section 14 of the **Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001** ("the Act"), as the Minister administering the Act, I declare the following area of land to be a permanent Commonwealth Games venue to which the Act applies:

the whole of the area of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre Development defined as being included in and forming part of:

- the land temporarily reserved by Order in Council dated 10 October 1995 published in the Government Gazette on 12 October 1995 for Public Park;
- the land permanently reserved by Order in Council dated 21 March 1876 published in the Government Gazette on 24 March 1876 for Public Park that is included in Crown Allotment 16E, Section 37B, City of South Melbourne;
- the land known as Crown Allotment 16F, Section 37B, City of South Melbourne being land temporarily reserved for Sport, Recreation, Entertainment, Social and Educational Activities under the **Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978** by Order in Council dated 17 July 2001 published in the Government Gazette on 19 July 2001; and
- the land reserved by Order in Council dated 21 March 1876 and published in the Government Gazette on 24 March 1876 that is permanently reserved for a Public Park shown hatched on the plan of survey No. GP1141,

as shown hatched on the plan of survey numbered LEGL./03-003 and lodged in the Central Plan Office.

This Order shall take effect from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001 COMMONWEALTH GAMES PROJECT ORDER

In accordance with section 15 of the **Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001** ("the Act"), as the Minister administering the Act, I declare the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre Development Project to be a Commonwealth Games Project to which the Act applies to develop facilities at a Commonwealth Games venue and to be developed for the purposes of the Commonwealth Games and I authorise the development of that project for the period commencing 30 August 2003 until 30 December 2005.

In accordance with sections 17 and 26 of the Act I specify that the Secretary to the Department for Victorian Communities, being a body corporate constituted under section 25A of the **Commonwealth Games Arrangements Act 2001**, is the person or body responsible for managing or developing the Commonwealth Games project to which this Order applies.
