



The diagram below illustrates the section of the road proposed to be renamed to "Tayton Avenue", Sorrento.



Upon reading the material submitted in support of the application the Tribunal is

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satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from Sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ two male workers to provide services to a male client of the Applicant's McPherson Community Program.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal

- The Richmond Fellowship of Victoria is an organisation which provides services to people with psychiatric and intellectual disabilities. Many of its programs are funded by the Department of Human Services.
- The McPherson Community Residential and Rehabilitation Program of the Applicant provides support to people with these disabilities in the Western Metropolitan Region.
- The services are aimed at helping these people to live more independently in an environment of their choice.
- Men with psychiatric and intellectual disabilities often experience acute loneliness, isolation and depression, and these experiences are often worsened by societal expectations concerning male behaviour. These men often find it difficult to relate to women and often exhibit challenging behaviours such as sexually inappropriate behaviour and verbal or physical aggression. There is a need for these men to experience a positive male role model to improve their ability to engage in appropriate relationships and behaviours.
- One of the male clients of the Program needs substantial support to be able to live off site, to assist him with personal hygiene and daily living activities, and to support him in other activities such as leisure and recreation and searching for a job. He has recently moved out of the Program's residential facility.
- The workers who support this client's needs need to be male because this client has a history of inappropriate behaviour to females, because this client sometimes exhibits intimidating or threatening behaviour or inappropriate hostility to others, and because this client needs support with hygiene and other personal care issues. Male workers will ensure his privacy and

comfort in these respects and will help him to develop appropriate relationships and behaviour and will assist him in developing healthy relationships with the wider community.

The application for exemption is to enable the applicant to advertise for and recruit women only to a pre-vocational training and employment placement program in relation to the information technology sector and, in particular, that part of the sector concerned with network administration or Internet infrastructure.

Upon reading the material submitted in support of the application the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from Sections 13, 35, 37, 42, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to advertise for and recruit women only to a prevocational training and employment placement program in relation to the information technology sector and, in particular, that part of the sector concerned with network administration or Internet infrastructure.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

 On 12 December 2000 the Applicant (under its former name Victec Group Training Ltd) was granted an exemption by this Tribunal to conduct this program. That exemption expired on 11 December 2003.

- After the previous exemption was granted, the Applicant first conducted a workshop to determine how its program might be structured so as to be attractive to women. It identified as factors which make the information communication technology ('ICT') industry less attractive to women as including the perception that the work is boring and contains too much jargon.
- It then conducted a series of group and individual selection interviews. It did not select candidates for the program by means of aptitude testing.
- There was a strong response from women to this approach. There were 200 applications of which 20 were selected to participate in the program. The candidates represented a diverse range of ages and educational backgrounds.
- The pre-vocational course was structured to include a variety of teaching methods including practical training and talks by external speakers. The course was customised for individual participants. The program also included 18 months of job placement in the industry, coupled with mentoring assistance. The certificates issued at the completion of the course and placement qualify the holder to work in the ICT industry.
- Of the 20 participants in the program 19 have been placed in ongoing employment.
- There has been positive feedback concerning the program from trainees, employers with whom trainees were placed and a wide variety of industry and other bodies including agencies who have equal employment opportunity responsibilities.
- The ICT industry still has a significant under representation of women.
- According to Victorian Government statistics as at June 2003 24% of the ICT workforce were women. There are still small numbers of women who undertake new apprenticeships in the ICT industry.
- Given the demand for this program, its success to date and the continuing under representation of women in the ICT industry the Applicant wishes to be able to continue to run this program.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE ESSENTIAL SERVICES COMMISSION AND THE PORT OF MELBOURNE CORPORATION

THIS MEMORANDUM is made on the 19th day of December 2003

PARTIES:

ESSENTIAL SERVICES COMMISSION (the "Commission")

and

PORT OF MELBOURNE CORPORATION (the "PoMC")

BACKGROUND:

- A. The PoMC is established by the PS Act. As a designated Channel Operator the PoMC employs the Harbour Master for the Port of Melbourne. The Harbour Master is licensed by the Director of Marine Safety who is the regulatory authority for marine safety in the Port of Melbourne.
- B. The parties have entered into this memorandum of understanding in order to provide for consultation and co-operation between them and the integration and co-ordination of their activities in regard to the Harbour Master's directions.
- C. This memorandum is not intended to deal with the Commission's role in regulating PoMC, particularly in relation to licensing or price and access regulation for prescribed services pursuant to the PS Act.
- D. This memorandum is also not intended to be used to interpret any legislative responsibilities of the PoMC, the Director of Marine Safety or the Commission.

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS:

1. Definitions

In this memorandum, including the background:

"ESC Act" means the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 (Vic);

"PS Act" means the Port Services Act 1995 (Vic);

"port waters" means the port waters of Melbourne as declared by Order in Council made under section 5(2) of the PS Act;

"prescribed agency" has the same meaning as in the ESC Act;

"regulated industry":

- (a) in clause 3 has the same meaning as in the ESC Act;
- (b) otherwise means the port industry in the Port of Melbourne in so far as it is concerned with channel access and marine safety.

2. Objectives and purpose of this memorandum

This memorandum seeks to:

- (a) ensure that the regulatory and decision making processes of the parties in relation to the regulated industry are closely integrated and better informed;
- (b) avoid overlap or conflict between regulatory schemes (either existing or proposed) affecting the regulated industry;
- (c) provide for sharing information between the parties in the context of their respective roles in relation to the regulated industry; and
- (d) promote the adoption of a best practice approach to regulation.

3. The role of the Commission

3.1 The Commission currently has functions relating to the economic regulation of the electricity, gas, ports, grain handling, freight rail, taxi, hire car, tow truck, statutory insurance and water industries. Its specific functions are:

- (a) to perform such functions as are conferred by the ESC Act and the relevant legislation under which a regulated industry operates;
- (b) to advise the relevant Minister on matters relating to the economic regulation of regulated industries, including reliability issues;
- (c) when requested by the Minister to do so, to conduct an inquiry into any systemic reliability of supply issues related to a regulated industry or other essential service specified by the Minister in the request;
- (d) to conduct inquiries and report under the ESC Act on matters relating to regulated industries;
- (e) to make determinations in accordance with the ESC Act;
- (f) to make recommendations to the Minister as to whether an industry which provides an essential service should become a regulated industry or whether a regulated industry should continue to be a regulated industry;
- (g) to conduct public education programs for the purpose of promoting its objectives under the ESC Act and the relevant legislation and in relation to significant changes in the regulation of a regulated industry;
- (h) to advise the Minister in relation to any other matter referred to the Commission by the Minister; and
- (i) to administer the ESC Act.
- 3.2 The Commission's primary objective in performing those functions is to protect the long-term interests of Victorian consumers with regard to the price, quality and reliability of essential services. In seeking to achieve that primary objective, the Commission must have regard to the following facilitating objectives:
 - (a) to facilitate efficiency in regulated industries and the incentive for efficient long-term investment;
 - (b) to facilitate the financial viability of regulated industries;
 - (c) to ensure that the misuse of monopoly or non-transitory market power is prevented;
 - (d) to facilitate effective competition and promote competitive market conduct;
 - (e) to ensure that regulatory decision making has regard to the relevant health, safety, environmental and social legislation applying to the regulated industry;
 - (f) to ensure that users and consumers (including low-income or vulnerable customers) benefit from the gains from competition and efficiency; and
 - (g) to promote consistency in regulation between States and on a national basis.
- 3.3 The Commission must also perform its functions and exercise its powers in such a manner as the Commission considers best achieves any objectives specified in the relevant legislation under which a regulated industry operates.
- 3.4 The Commission has specific statutory functions under Part 3, Division 4 of the PS Act to make access determinations about channels.

4. The role of the PoMC

- 4.1 The PoMC is a body corporate with perpetual succession.
- 4.2 The objectives of the PoMC are:
 - (a) to manage and develop the port of Melbourne in an economically, socially and environmentally sustainable manner;
 - (b) to ensure that essential port services of the port of Melbourne are available and cost effective:
 - (c) to ensure, in co-operation with other relevant responsible bodies, that the port of Melbourne is effectively integrated with other systems of infrastructure in the State;

- (d) to facilitate, in co-operation with other relevant responsible bodies, the sustainable growth of trade through the port of Melbourne; and
- (e) to establish and manage channels in port of Melbourne waters for use on a fair and reasonable basis.
- 4.3 For the purposes of coordinating regulatory functions, the relevant functions of PoMC are:
 - (a) to manage and, in accordance with standards developed by the Director of Marine Safety, to dredge and maintain channels in port of Melbourne waters;
 - (b) to provide and maintain, in accordance with the standards developed by the Director of Marine Safety, navigation aids in connection with navigation in port of Melbourne waters; and
 - (c) generally, to direct and control, in accordance with the **Marine Act 1988**, the movement of vessels in port of Melbourne waters.
- 4.4 The PoMC must carry out its functions, including those identified under 4.3, in a manner that:
 - (a) is safe and secure;
 - (b) is environmentally sustainable;
 - (c) is effective and efficient;
 - (d) is commercially sound; and
 - (e) has regard for the persons living or working in the immediate neighbourhood of the Port of Melbourne.
- 4.5 The PoMC has specific statutory obligations under Part 6 of the PS Act to engage a harbour master
- 4.6 A harbour master has, in relation to the port waters for which he or she is the harbour master, such functions as are conferred on a harbour master by the PS Act.
- 4.7 The functions of a harbour master may be limited by a condition imposed by the Director of Marine Safety on his or her licence.
- 4.8 A harbour master's licence may contain a condition that makes the exercise of his or her functions subject to any directions given from time to time to the harbour master by the Director of Marine Safety.
- 4.9 Subject to any directions given by the channel operator by which he or she is engaged, a harbour master may authorise a person approved by the channel operator to exercise, in relation to the port waters for which he or she is the harbour master, the harbour master's functions under the PS Act. An authorisation may be general or may apply only to the exercise of such functions as are specified in the instrument of authorisation.

5. How the parties will consult

- 5.1 Where relevant, the Commission will, as early as practicable, consult with the PoMC:
 - (a) in the making of a determination;
 - (b) in the conduct of an inquiry or investigation, after first consulting with the Minister; and
 - (c) in preparing and reviewing the Commission's Charter of Consultation and Regulatory Practice.
- 5.2 The PoMC will, if requested in writing by the Commission to do so, consult with the Commission:
 - (a) in relation to any matter specified by the Commission which is relevant to its objectives or functions; and
 - (b) in respect of a matter specified by the Commission which may impact on the regulated industry.

- 5.3 Each party having regard to their respective roles in relation to the regulated industry will:
 - (a) consult with and involve the other in the performance of any function relevant to harbour management or channels that has or is likely to have material implications for the other;
 - (b) ensure that such consultation occurs as early as practicable in the parties' regulatory, advisory or decision making processes;
 - (c) on request, provide the other with timely advice on regulatory matters for which it is responsible;
 - (d) provide the other with timely relevant information on industry issues for which both parties have some responsibility;
 - (e) promptly inform the other of any material changes to its role or to the regulatory arrangements it administers;
 - (f) exchange details of annual work programs to the extent that they are relevant to the role of the other;
 - (g) provide the other with advance notice of its intention to undertake a major review or activity that will or may have material implications for the other;
 - (h) identify opportunities to coordinate strategic planning and undertake knowledge sharing initiatives to optimise mutual understanding of roles and strategic directions;
 - (i) identify relevant project officers to allow for the coordination of particular regulatory projects; and
 - (j) publish this memorandum on its website.

6. How the parties will manage their relationship and resolve disputes

- 6.1 Each party will ensure that, at all times while this memorandum is in force, one of its staff members is designated and known to the other as its contact officer for the purposes of this memorandum.
- 6.2 At the date of this memorandum, the contact officer for the Commission is Mr Andrew Chow, and the contact officer for the PoMC is Sandra Gatehouse. Each party will give notice of any change to its contact officer to the other, promptly after the change is made.
- 6.3 Each party will ensure that its contact officer:
 - (a) makes themself (or an alternate) available at all relevant times to address any questions, concerns or disputes arising out of the operation of this memorandum which are raised by either party;
 - (b) instigates periodic (and in any event not less than three-yearly) reviews of this memorandum directed, in particular, to the potential for improvement in its terms or operation and to the effect (if any) of regulatory change on its terms, operation or utility; and
 - (c) arranges (in conjunction with the other's contact officer) such meetings of appropriate staff of the parties as and when necessary or desirable to facilitate the efficient and effective operation of this memorandum and including, in any event, a meeting of respective Chairpersons of the parties no less frequently than annually.
- 6.4 If there is a dispute between the parties as to the terms or operation of this memorandum, each party will ensure that its contact officer endeavours in good faith to resolve that dispute with the other's contact officer. If, however, a contact officer gives notice to the other party's contact officer of the view that the dispute is unlikely to be resolved by discussions between the contact officers, then each party's contact officer must promptly:
 - (a) brief the party's Chairperson (or a nominee of the party's Chairperson) of details of the relevant dispute; and
 - (b) arrange with the other's contact officer for a meeting of the Chairpersons of the parties (or their respective nominees), with the objective of settling the dispute amicably.

7. Use and disclosure of information

- 7.1 The capacity of a party to use or disclose information, or take information into account, is or may be (depending on the nature or source of the information) restricted by law.
- 7.2 If a party discloses information to the other party under this memorandum, the disclosing party may place restrictions on the recipient's use or disclosure of that information, being restrictions it believes in good faith are necessary for compliance with binding restrictions on disclosure. A party receiving information will observe any such restriction noting, however, that this requirement does not limit:
 - (a) any other legal obligation of a party relating to the disclosure or use of information; and
 - (b) any right of a party concerning information obtained otherwise than under this memorandum.

MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 1

The Minister for Education and Training makes the following Order:

PART 1 - PRELIMINARY

1. Title

This Order may be cited as Ministerial Order No. 1

2. Purposes of this Order

This Order fixes rules with respect to the procedure to be followed on an application for review for the purposes of section 18L of the **Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority Act 2000**. Section 18L(1) states that a student affected by a decision of the Review Committee, other than a decision under section 18K of the Act, may apply for a review of the decision by an Appeals Committee on one or both of the following grounds—

- the decision was unreasonable;
- the penalty imposed was too harsh

3. Authorising Provisions and Commencement

This Order is made under section 18L(8) of the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority Act 2000 and comes into operation the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

4. Definitions

In this Order:

"Act" means Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority Act 2000 (as amended).

- "Appeals Committee" means an appeals committee appointed pursuant to section 18M of the Act.
- "Authority" means Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority.
- "CEO" means the Chief Executive Officer of the Authority.
- "Review Committee" means a review committee constituted pursuant to section 12(3A) of the Act.

PART 2 - PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED ON APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW TO AN APPEALS COMMITTEE

- 5. An application for review made by a student under section 18L(1) of the Act must be in or to the effect of Form 1 of the Schedule to this Order.
- **6.** Subject to the Act—
 - (i) a student's application for review and any written submission from the student must not introduce evidence or documents not presented to or considered by the Review Committee, and
 - (ii) the CEO may accept a student's application for review which is not in or to the effect of Form 1 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 7. A student who wishes to make a written submission to the Appeals Committee must deliver the written submission to the CEO no later than 14 days after the day on which the Review Committee gave its decision orally at the hearing.
- 8. In exceptional circumstances, the Appeals Committee may in its discretion extend the period in which a student may make a written submission if written application has been made by or on behalf of a student to the CEO setting out the exceptional circumstances. The CEO must provide to the Appeals Committee any such application for consideration by the Appeals Committee.
- 9. The CEO must refer an application made by a student under section 18L(1) of the Act to an Appeals Committee as soon as practicable for determination, and in any event no later than 14 days after receiving the student's application for review.
- **10.** The CEO must provide to the Appeals Committee:
 - the documents which were before the Review Committee;
 - the written decision of the Review Committee; and
 - the student's application for review and any written submission made by the student.
- 11. The Appeals Committee to which an application for review under section 18L(1) of the Act has been referred by the CEO for determination—
 - (i) shall meet as soon as reasonably practicable but not earlier than 14 days after the date on which the Review Committee gave its decision orally at the hearing, and not later than 28 days after receiving the application for review from the CEO,
 - (ii) must determine the application for review as soon as reasonably practicable,
 - (iii) must notify the Authority without delay of its determination of an application for review,
 - (iv) must set out in its determination the reasons for its determination.
- **12.** The CEO must notify the student of the determination of the Appeals Committee without delay.
- 13. If the decision of the Appeals Committee is to vary the decision under review or to set aside the decision under review, the Authority shall give effect to the decision and make any necessary amendments or alterations in the records of the Authority relating to the student.
- 14. If a student's assessment is amended or cancelled, the Authority:

- must give written notice to the student concerned that the record of assessment has been so amended or cancelled as the case requires; and
- may give written notice to any other person to whom a copy of the student's record has previously been provided by the Authority.
- **15.** Any notice given by the CEO to a student may be given by being posted by prepaid ordinary post and such notice shall be deemed to be given if so posted on the third day after posting.
- **16.** A member of the Appeals Committee must disqualify himself or herself if he or she is involved (as a party or witness) or has other substantial reason to believe that he or she could not be impartial or may be reasonably perceived as not being impartial.
- 17. Subject to the Act and this Order the Committee may regulate its own procedure and must act fairly.
