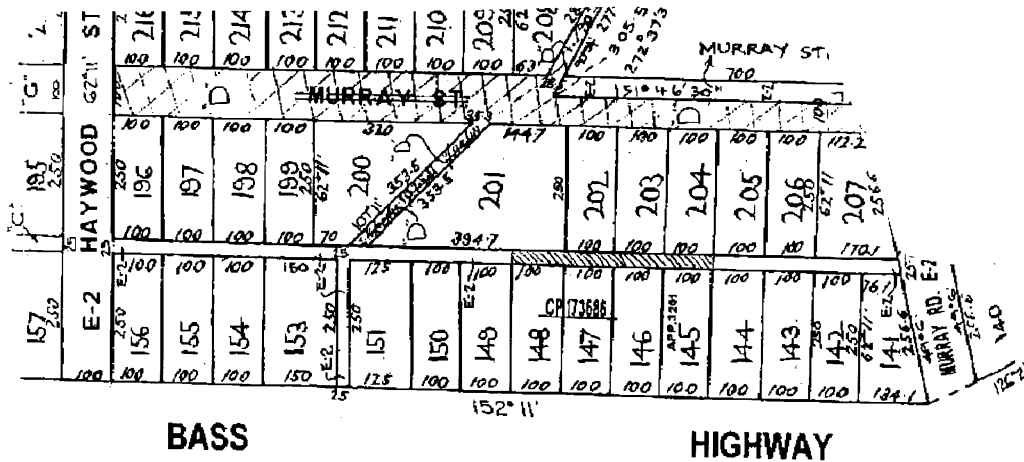

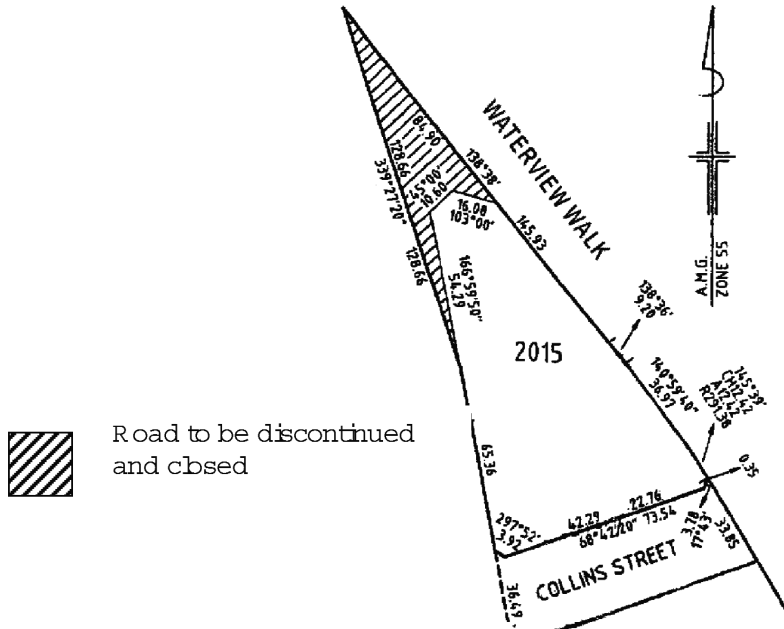

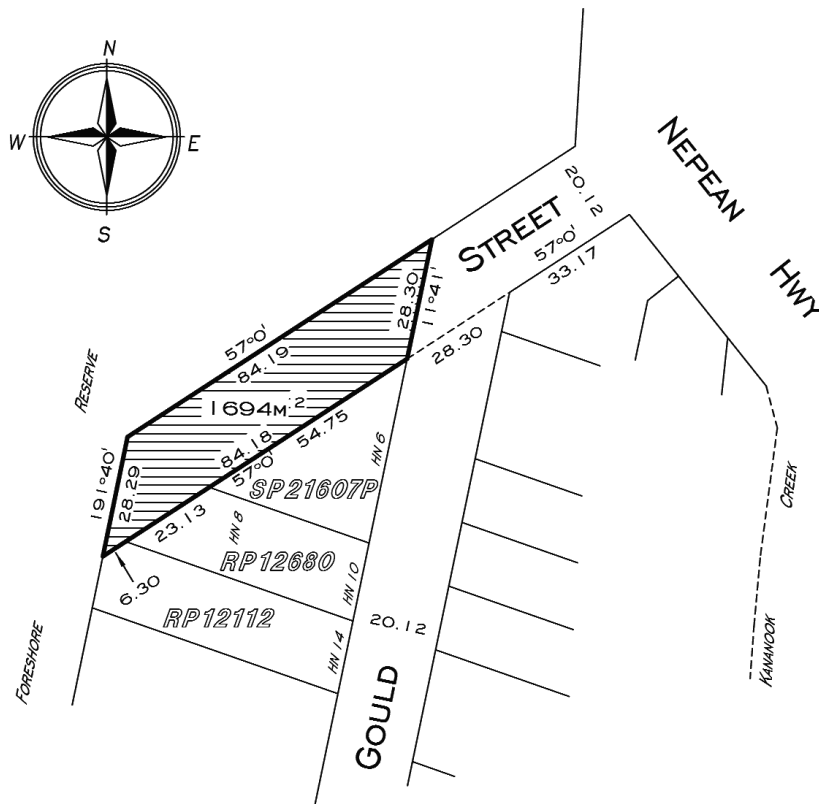

MEETING PROCEDURE LOCAL LAW

Notice is hereby given that the Nillumbik Shire Council (the Council) at its meeting on 28 January 2004 amended Local Law No. 6—Meeting Procedure Local Law.

The purpose of the amendment is:

- Supplementary and Urgent Business—Clause 24.11: to ensure only matters of the utmost urgency are dealt with which have had the appropriate investigation undertaken;
- Foreshadowed Motion—Clause 33: to clarify the provision of foreshadowed motions to be raised during debate;
- Procedural Motions—Clause 34: clarification of the process for formally moving motions;
- Procedure Not Provided in Local Law—Clause 62: to stipulate which House of Parliament is the reference point;
- Interruptions, Interjections and Relevance—Clause 36: avoid unnecessary interruptions during debate.

The Local Law will come into effect on 5 February 2004.

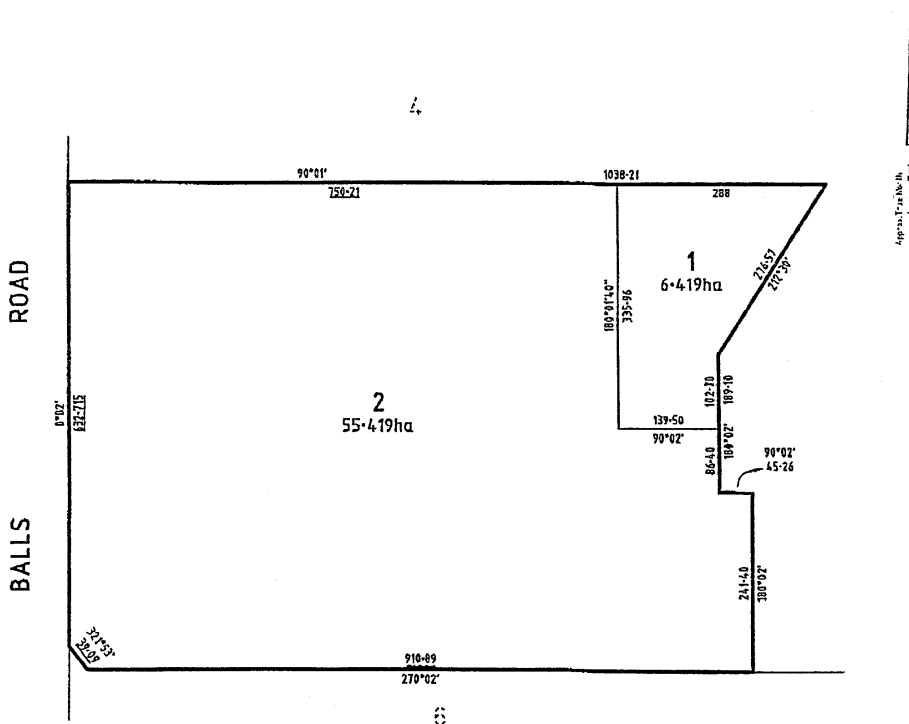

ORDERS IN COUNCIL**Electricity Industry Act 2000**

ORDER UNDER SECTION 17

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, acting under section 17 of the **Electricity Industry Act 2000** and section 27 of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984** makes the following order:

1. Murraylink Transmission Company Pty Ltd (A.C.N. 089 875 605) ("MTC") is exempt from the requirement to obtain a licence for the transmission of electricity in Victoria through that part of the electricity transmission system that links the South Australian electricity grid near Berri, with the Victorian electricity grid near Red Cliffs situated in Victoria ("Murraylink").
2. This exemption is subject to the following conditions in relation to Murraylink:
 - (a) MTC must register as a Code participant within the meaning of the National Electricity Code;
 - (b) MTC must comply with the System Code as administered by the Essential Services Commission ("the Commission") unless the Commission has notified MTC that it need not comply with any provision of the System Code;
 - (c) MTC must enter into a connection agreement with SPI PowerNet Pty Ltd;
 - (d) MTC must offer to enter into a network agreement with the Victorian Energy Networks Corporation ("VENCorp") on fair and reasonable terms, within 20 business days after a request by VENCorp to do so;
 - (e) MTC must not augment Murraylink except:
 - (i) in accordance with any guidelines published by the Commission in relation to augmentation; and
 - (ii) pursuant to a network agreement with VENCorp or a connection agreement with a distributor, generator or customer;
 - (f) MTC must, if requested in writing by VENCorp, provide to VENCorp such documents or information as VENCorp may reasonably require to perform its functions and exercise its powers under the **Electricity Industry Act 2000**.
 - (g) On request by any of the persons listed in the Schedule, MTC must offer to provide connection to Murraylink or to increase the performance of an existing connection to Murraylink on fair and reasonable terms. Such offer by MTC must be made within 65 business days after receiving a request or all information which MTC reasonably requires in order to make such an offer (whichever is the later). MTC may refuse to make an offer where it already has made an offer to provide the services sought in accordance with this paragraph and clause 2 of this Order and the offer has not been accepted.
3. Any question as to the reasonableness of a requirement by VENCorp for MTC to provide information pursuant to clause 2(f) of this Order or for MTC to seek information as contemplated by clause 2(g) of this Order shall be decided by the Commission on the basis of the Commission's opinion of the reasonableness of the requirement.
4. Any question as to the fairness and reasonableness of any offer pursuant to clause 2(d) or clause 2(g) of this Order shall be decided by the Commission on the basis of the Commission's opinion of the fairness and reasonableness of the offer.
5. The Order in Council made on 2 August 2000 under Section 160 of the **Electricity Industry Act 1993** and published in the Government Gazette on 3 August 2000 is revoked.
6. This Order commences on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.
7. A reference in this order to a body corporate includes its administrators, successors, liquidators and assigns.

8. In this Order:
- “**connection agreement**” means an agreement relating to the provision of connection services;
- “**connection services**” means the services of establishing and maintaining connection between Murraylink and another electrical system or electrical installation.
