#### National Parks Act 1975

SECTION 37AA

Notice of authorisation of the Secretary to the Department of Sustainability and Environment

The Secretary to the Department of Sustainability and Environment hereby:

(a) revokes the authorisation under section 37AA of the **National Parks Act 1975** published in the Victoria Government Gazette No. S 217 on 15 November 2002

and

(b) authorises under section 37AA(1) of the **National Parks Act 1975** that any spear gun (see note 1) or hand held spear may be carried by, or be in the possession of, any person in any of the following parks —

Bunurong Marine National Park Cape Howe Marine National Park Churchill Island Marine National Park Corner Inlet Marine National Park Discovery Bay Marine National Park French Island Marine National Park Ninety Mile Beach Marine National Park Point Addis Marine National Park Point Hicks Marine National Park Port Phillip Heads Marine National Park Twelve Apostles Marine National Park Wilsons Promontory Marine National Park Yaringa Marine National Park

Barwon Bluff Marine Sanctuary Beware Reef Marine Sanctuary Eagle Rock Marine Sanctuary Jawbone Marine Sanctuary Marengo Reefs Marine Sanctuary Merri Marine Sanctuary Mushroom Reef Marine Sanctuary Point Cooke Marine Sanctuary Point Danger Marine Sanctuary Ricketts Point Marine Sanctuary The Arches Marine Sanctuary

and

- (c) specifies under section 37AA(2) of the National Parks Act 1975 that the authorisation under section 37AA(1) of the National Parks Act 1975 is for a period of three years from 1 April 2004 and is subject to the following conditions
  - in relation to a spear gun (see note 1), the spear or arrow must be separated from the gun or sling at all times
  - in relation to a hand held spear, the prongs must be detached from the shaft, and if that is not possible, the prongs must not be exposed and must be kept protected at all times.

Notes:

- 1. "Spear gun" means a mechanical device or other thing that is capable of imparting propulsive energy to a spear or arrow and includes an Hawaiian sling.
- 2. On and after 1 April 2004 it will be an offence under the **National Parks Act 1975** to use a spear gun or hand held spear in any of the areas specified in paragraph (b) of this authorisation.
