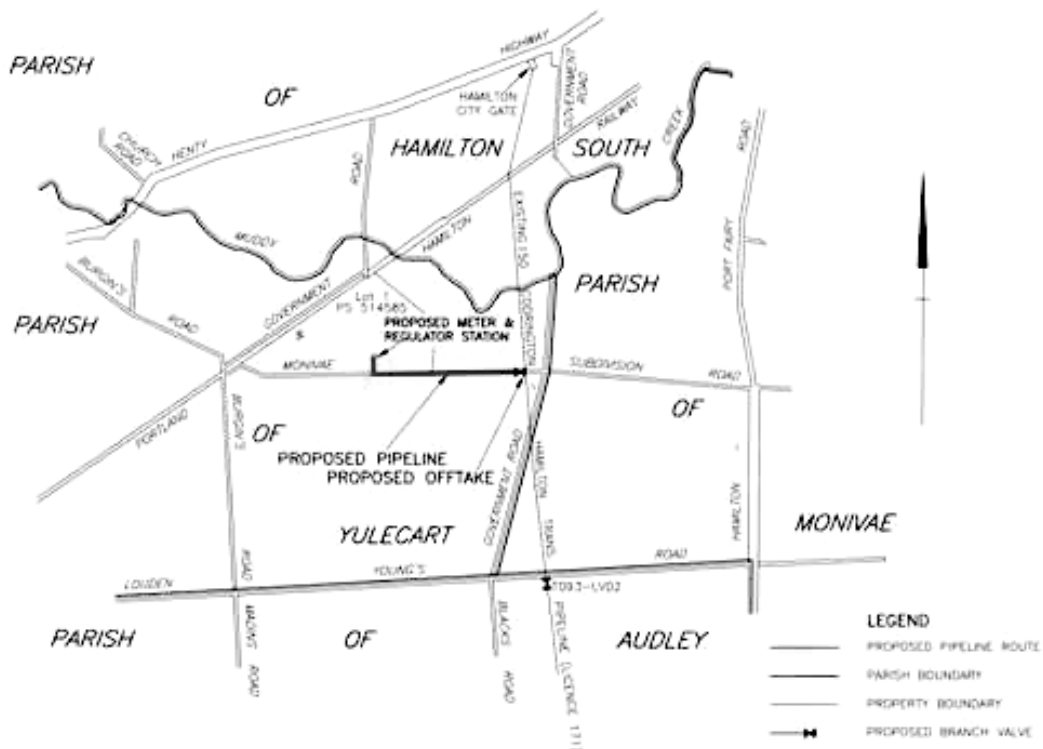

Pipelines Act 1967 (Vic)

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE PIPELINES ACT 1967 (VIC)

Application for a Permit to Own and Use Pipeline 252

1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 11 of the **Pipelines Act 1967 (Vic)**, notice is given that an application has been received from GasNet Australia (Operations) Pty Ltd (the applicant) for a Permit to Own and Use a Pipeline for the purpose of conveying natural gas from GasNet's Codrington to Hamilton gas transmission pipeline (PL171) to approximately 200 metres within the property boundary of the Douglas mineral separation plant.
2. The proposed route of the pipeline is described and shown on the map below:
A 100mm nominal bore steel pipeline, approximately 1.1 kms in length, commencing at GasNet's Codrington to Hamilton gas transmission pipeline (PL171) travelling in a westerly direction within Monivae Subdivision Road reserve for approximately 900 metres then turning to a northerly direction to enter the Douglas mineral separation plant and terminating approximately 200 metres inside the property boundary.
