Road Safety Act 1986

ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 1999

Notice concerning Road Train Routes

Clause 21 of Schedule 2 to the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1999 provides that a road train may only be used on a highway in an area, or on a route, specified by the Roads Corporation by Notice published in the Government Gazette.

Clause 31 of Schedule 2 to the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1999 provides that a prime mover, semi-trailer and converter dolly combination may only be used on a highway in an area, or on a route, specified by the Roads Corporation by Notice published in the Government Gazette.

In accordance with those provisions, I, Ted Vincent, delegate of the Roads Corporation, specify that -

- (1) the routes on which road trains, meeting the description set out in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to the Regulations, may be used are routes consisting only of one or more of the following:
 - Adams Street, Mildura;
 - Buronga–Mildura South Road (Benetook Avenue and Seventh Street East) between Adams Street and the Sturt Highway;
 - Cureton Avenue between Sturt Highway and Seventh Street East for south bound travel only;
 - Sturt Highway between Buronga–Mildura South Road and the New South Wales border;
 - Calder Highway between New South Wales border at Yelta (Abbotsford Bridge) and Meridian Road;
 - Meridian Road between the Calder Highway and the last access point into the Grain Corp receival bunkers at Yelta, no further than the intersection of Old Mail Road;
- (2) the routes on which a prime mover, semi-trailer and converter dolly combination, meeting the description set out in Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Regulations, may be used are all highways in Victoria.

In this Notice, unless the contrary intention appears, expressions used have the same meaning as in the **Road Safety Act 1986** and the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1999.

Nothing in this Notice authorises the driving of a road train or a prime mover, semi-trailer and converter dolly combination in a manner or in a condition or place that is otherwise prohibited by the Regulations.

The Notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette No S21 of 4 February 2005 concerning specified road train routes is revoked.

This Notice operates from the date of its publication in the Victoria Government Gazette until 1 February 2010.
