Control of Genetically Modified Crops Act 2004

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF THRESHOLD AMOUNT FOR THE PRESENCE OF CERTAIN GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISIMS IN CROPS

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under section 7 of the **Control of Genetically Modified Crops Act 2004**, determine that the threshold amount for the presence of the genetically modified organisms specified in the Schedule to this Notice in crops is 0.9%.

This Notice takes effect on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

Note: Section 7 of the **Control of Genetically Modified Crops Act 2004** provides that if the amount of a GMO that is present in a crop does not exceed the threshold amount determined for that GMO, the presence of the GMO in that crop is to be disregarded for the purposes of the **Control of Genetically Modified Crops Act 2004**.

SCHEDULE

Genetically Modified Organisms

Plants of the species Brassica napus, common name canola, tolerant to the herbicide glufosinate ammonium due to genetic modification derived from lines T45, Topas 19/2, MS1, MS8, RF1, RF2 and RF3 defined in the application under section 40 of the Gene Technology Act 2000 of the Commonwealth designated DIR010/2001 and DIR021/2002 made to the Gene Technology Regulator appointed under section 118 of the Gene Technology Act 2000 of the Commonwealth.

Note: This refers to canola plants (generally but not exclusively known as InVigor Canola) which have been genetically modified and have been licensed under the **Gene Technology Act 2000** of the Commonwealth for intentional release into the environment.

2. Plants of the species Brassica napus, common name canola, tolerant to the herbicide glyphosate due to genetic modification derived from transformation event GT73 defined in the application under section 40 of the **Gene Technology Act 2000** of the Commonwealth designated DIR020/2002 made to the Gene Technology Regulator appointed under section 118 of the **Gene Technology Act 2000** of the Commonwealth.

Note: This refers to canola plants (known as Roundup Ready® Canola) which have been genetically modified and have been licensed under the Gene Technology Act of the Commonwealth for intentional release into the environment.
