I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 198**8 that:

- (1) bathing and the operation of vessels is prohibited on the waters of Victoria Harbour within the areas detailed in Table 2 and at the times as specified in Table 1 excluding those persons and vessels involved in the events and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria.
- (2) the vessels involved with the Wakeboard Victoria Round 1 event listed in this Notice are excluded from Clauses 2(a), 3(a), 3(b), 7 and 14 of Notice No.1 made under s.15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the times detailed in Table 1.
- (3) At the completion of the event specified above, and as determined and announced by the Parks Victoria Ranger in Charge Yarra River, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No.1 made under subsection 15(2) of the Marine Act 1988.

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) bathing and the operation of vessels are prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River between 100 metres upstream of the Powerhouse Landing to the downstream edge of the Sandridge Rail Bridge between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 10.30 a.m. on Saturday, 19 November 2005, excluding vessels involved with The Melbourne Head Regatta and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria.
- (b) the vessels involved with The Melbourne Head Rowing Regatta are excluded from Clauses 3(a), 3(b) and 7 of Notice No. 1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the period specified above.
- (c) At the completion of the event and as determined and announced by the Parks Victoria Ranger in Charge Yarra River, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No.1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
