Subordinate Legislation Act 1994 NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Forests (Thomson River Forest Reserve) Regulations 2005

Notice is given under section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Forests (Thomson River Forest Reserve) Regulations 2005

The objectives of the existing and proposed Regulations are to provide for:

- (a) the effective management and conservation of the Thomson River Forest Reserve;
- (b) periodic road closures within the area of the reserve; and
- (c) appropriate land uses within the reserve.

The proposed Regulations replace the Forests (Thomson River Forest Reserve) Regulations 1995, which are due to expire on 3 April 2005.

The RIS explores three possible alternatives to the proposed Regulations:

- (a) the use of widespread signs:
- (b) the use of voluntary codes on those licences to effect adequate reserve protection; and
- (c) the introduction of a permit system.

The RIS concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most effective means of meeting the stated objectives by continuing to protect the catchment and ensure continued delivery of high quality water from the Thomson Reservoir.

Public comments or submissions are invited on the proposed Regulations and RIS. All
