A TEMPORARY RESERVATION OF CROWN LAND

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under section 62(2) of the **Mitcham–Frankston Project Act 2004** (“the Act”), on the recommendation of the Minister for Transport, given in accordance with section 62(1) of that Act, revokes the Order in Council dated 4 December 2001 which temporarily reserved certain land for conservation, recreation, leisure and tourism purposes, to the extent that the Order in Council of 4 December 2001 (referred to above) relates to the land shown as shaded on the plans lodged at the Central Plan Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment and numbered:

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under section 55(1)(b) of the **Mitcham–Frankston Project Act 2004** (“the Act”), on the recommendation of the Minister for Transport and the recommendation of the Minister for Local Government, given in accordance with section 55(5) of the Act:

- a) divests from the Manningham City Council the land shown as hatched on the plan lodged in the Central Plan Office at the Department of Sustainability and Environment and numbered LEGL./05–031 in stratum from below 10 metres below the existing surface of the land, the surface boundaries of which are more particularly described on that plan by reference to survey plans SP20889 and SP20025A;
- b) excludes the operation of section 57(3) of the Act from the land shown as hatched referred to in paragraph (a) above that is, or is being used as, a road; and
- c) specifies, under section 66 of the Act, that the existing surface of the land shown as hatched and referred to in paragraph (a) above that was a municipal road before the publication of this Order continues to be a municipal road after the publication of this Order.
