ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA NEAR WAAIA FOR THE CONTROL OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

1. Objective

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly near Waaia and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

2. Authorising provisions

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. Definition

In this Order-

- (a) "Act" means the Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995; and
- (b) "Queensland Fruit Fly" means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggart); and
- (c) "Regulations" mean the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

4. Restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly

The restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly is declared to be the areas described in Schedules 1 and 2.

5. *Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements*

- (1) The removal from the restricted area into any part of Victoria of any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations is prohibited unless the fruit or vegetable is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate, Plant Health Assurance Certificate or Plant Health Declaration, and in the case of fruit for treatment, packing or processing outside the restricted area, is accompanied by a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.
- (2) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2 must give access to such land at all times to an inspector, after 24 hours notice is given to the occupier or if the occupier consents to the entry, for the purpose of inspection, placing on such land any lures or traps, applying on such land any spray material or bait and performing any other actions in accordance with section 52 of the Act which in the opinion of the authorised officer are necessary for the eradication or prevention of spread of the pest.
- (3) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, on instructions from an inspector, must strip fruit from trees, collect and dispose of waste fruit, or treat fruit and vegetables listed as hosts of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations in a manner approved by the Secretary.



- (4) Any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations which is transported through the restricted area, from areas free of Queensland Fruit Fly, must be transported in accordance with the conditions of a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.
- (5) A person responsible for importing, introducing or bringing any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations into any part of Victoria from the restricted area is required to present the material for inspection, examination or treatment and the accompanying Plant Health Certificate, Assurance Certificate, or Plant Health Declaration for inspection and examination at a place prescribed in the Regulations or a place nominated by an inspector.

Schedule 1

The area of land bounded by a line commencing where Walshs Bridge Road intersects with the Goulburn Valley Highway, then in a westerly direction along Walshs Bridge Road, to the intersection of Walshs Bridge Road and Central Mundoona Road, then in a southerly direction along Central Mundoona Road to the intersection of Central Mundoona Road and Kaarimba Road, then in a westerly direction along Kaarimba Road, to the intersection of Kaarimba Road and McPhersons Road, then in a southerly direction along McPhersons Road to the intersection of McPhersons Road and Osbornes Road, then in a westerly direction along Osbornes Road, which continues as Sandilands Road, to the Goulburn River, then in a westerly direction, downstream, to the intersection of the Goulburn River and Frasers Road, then in a northerly direction along Frasers Road to the intersection of Frasers Road and the Murray Valley Highway, then in a westerly direction along the Murray Valley Highway to the intersection of the Murray Valley Highway and Boals Lane, then in a northerly direction along Boals Lane to the intersection of Boals Lane and Griffiths Lane, then in a westerly, then northerly, direction along Griffiths Lane to the intersection of Griffiths Lane and Tucketts Road, then in a westerly direction along Tucketts Road to the intersection of Tucketts Road and Fairmans Road, then in a northerly direction along Fairmans Road to the intersection of Fairmans Road and Lindsay Road, then in an easterly direction along Lindsay Road to the intersection of Lindsay Road and Murray Road, then in a northerly direction along Murray Road to the intersection of Murray Road and Lyles Road, then in an easterly direction along Lyles Road to the intersection of Lyles Road and Baxters Road, then in a northerly direction along Baxters Road to the intersection of Baxters Road and Vales Road, then in an easterly direction along Vales Road to the intersection of Vales Road and Cottams Road, then in a northerly direction along Cottams Road to the intersection of Cottams Road and Muntz Road, then in an easterly direction along Muntz Road to the intersection of Muntz Road and Orrs Road, then in a northerly direction along Orrs Road to the intersection of Orrs Road and Sleemans Road, then in an easterly direction along Sleemans Road to the intersection of Sleemans Road and the Murray Valley Highway, then in a northerly, then easterly, direction along the Murray Valley Highway to the intersection of the Murray Valley Highway and Tyacks Road, then in a southerly direction along Tyacks Road to the intersection of Tyacks Road and Ryans Road, then in an easterly direction along Ryans Road to the intersection of Ryans Road and Boals Road; then in a southerly direction along Boals Road to the intersection of Boals Road and Henderson Road, then in an easterly direction along Hendersons Road to the intersection of Hendersons Road and Boothroyds Road, then in a southerly direction along Boothroyds Road to the intersection of Boothroyds Road and Spences Road, then in an easterly direction along Spences Road to the intersection of Spences Road and Shinnicks Road, then in a southerly direction along Shinnicks Road to the intersection of Shinnicks Road and Orams Road; then in an easterly direction along Orams Road to the intersection of Orams Road and the Goulburn Valley Highway, then in a southerly direction along the Goulburn Valley Highway to the point of commencement.

Schedule 2

The area of land within a radius of one and a half kilometres of the affected property at 36.05752° South, 145.27237° East.

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
