NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT (RIS)

Building (Owner-builder) Regulations 2005

Notice is given that, in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**, a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the Building (Owner-builder) Regulations 2005.

The proposed Regulations prescribe information to be supplied by applicants for consent to carry out domestic building work as an owner-builder, the fee payable for an application, the information to be contained on a certificate of consent and the information to be contained in the register of certificates of consent.

The RIS discusses possible alternatives to the proposed Regulations and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the best means of achieving the stated objectives.
