### Road Safety Act 1986

#### EXEMPTION FROM ROAD RULE 270 FOR FILMING OF "LITTLE OBERON"

I, Peter Batchelor, Minister for Transport, acting under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act** 1986 ("the Act") and on the application of Christie Films Pty Ltd (ABN 60 107 011 969) declare that Road Rule 270 (wearing of motor bike helmets) does not apply to the non-road activities specified in column 1 of the Schedule conducted on the highways or parts of highways specified column 2 of the Schedule during the periods specified in column 3 of the Schedule, subject to the following conditions:

- a. That a permit has been issued for the relevant non-road activities by the relevant road authority under section 99B(1) of the Act.
- b. That any motorbike used for the non-road activity does not exceed a speed of 30 km/hr.
- c. That the parts of the highways used for the non-road activity are closed to traffic during the times when the activity is actually being carried out (which may not be the full period referred to in column 3 of the Schedule).
- d. That all safety requirements are complied with including (without limitation) all other provisions of the Act, the Road Rules Victoria, the Road Management Act 2004 and the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1985 and any regulations under those Acts.
