- a) adding the land shown as shaded on the plans lodged at the Central Plan Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment and numbered LEGL./05-047, LEGL./05-048, LEGL./05-061, LEGL./05-064 and LEGL./05-065, the boundaries of the land shown as shaded being more particularly described on those plans by reference to parcels of land identified by number and defined by survey plans identified as "SP" with numbers following;
