Subordinate Legislation Act 1994

NOTICE THAT STATUTORY RULES HAVE BEEN MADE

Notice is given under section 16 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that the following Regulations were made on 28 June 2005 and commenced on that day.

• Transport (Taxi-Cabs) Regulations 2005

These Regulations replace the Transport (Taxi-Cabs) Regulations 1994 and prescribe measures intended to enhance passenger and driver safety and the reliability and quality of taxi-cab services, including requirements for or in relation to:

- driver certification, conduct and presentation
- vehicle construction, equipment, appearance and operation
- hirings, the charging and payment of fares and charges and the operation of taximeters, and
- the conduct of passengers.

• Transport (Passenger Vehicles) Regulations 2005

These Regulations replace the Transport (Passenger Vehicles) Regulations 1994 and will facilitate the safe and efficient operation of buses, hire cars and other small passenger vehicles (excluding taxi-cabs) and to enable comfortable and convenient travel on those vehicles. This includes the regulation of:

- driver and operator authorisation, including provision for the issue of drivers' certificates
- record keeping
- vehicle standards and displays
- vehicle operation and driver conduct
- fares, tickets and timetables, and
- passenger behaviour.

• Transport (Ticketing and Conduct) Regulations 2005

These Regulations replace the Transport (Passengers and Rail Freight) Regulations 1994 to:

- prescribe ticket conditions;
- regulate the use of tickets and other behaviour;
- regulate the use of seating and other accommodation on public transport vehicles;
- regulate the conduct of persons on and in relation to public transport vehicles and premises.
- Transport (Infringements) (Consequential and Restructuring Amendment) Regulations 2005

These Regulations make consequential and restructuring amendments to existing infringements regulations.
