CORRECTIONS (POLICE GAOLS) REGULATIONS 2005

The proposed Corrections (Police Gaols) Regulations 2005 and Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) are now available for public comment.

The Corrections (Police Gaols) Regulations 2005 will replace the Corrections (Police Gaols) Regulations 1995, which sunset on 28 August 2005.

The object of the Regulations is to provide for the management, administration and security of police gaols and for the safe custody and welfare of persons detained in them, by making provision for:

- the receipt of identifying information about detainees and visitors;
- identification and verification of the identity of visitors;
- the manner of dealing with seized items;
- restrictions on communication and exchange of articles between visitors and detainees;
- directions to be given to detainees to ensure the good order of police gaols; and
- the investigation of suspected contraventions of the Regulations.

The proposed Regulations also allow for the use of restraints in particular circumstances, and for the transfer of persons in the legal custody of the Chief Commissioner of Police from a police gaol to a hospital, specialist clinic for psychological or psychiatric examination or a centre for the treatment of alcoholics or drug dependent persons.

The RIS examines the proposed regulatory regime and alternatives to the proposed Regulations. The RIS concludes that the proposed Regulations will generate the greatest benefits for the Victorian community.
