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## Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995

### ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA NEAR BAIRNSDALE FOR THE CONTROL OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

**1. Objective**

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly at Fairhope, near Bairnsdale, and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

**2. Authorising provisions**

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

**3. Definition**

In this Order—

“**Act**” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**; and

“**Queensland Fruit Fly**” means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggart); and

“**Regulations**” mean the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

**4. Restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly**

The restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly is declared to be the area described in Schedule 1.

**5. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements**

- (1) The removal from the restricted area into any part of Victoria of any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland fruit fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations is prohibited unless the fruit or vegetable is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate, Assurance Certificate or Plant Health Declaration, and in the case of fruit for treatment, packing or processing outside the restricted area, is accompanied by a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.
- (2) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2 must give access to such land at all times to an inspector, after 24 hours notice is given to the occupier or if the occupier consents to the entry, for the purpose of inspection, placing on such land any lures or traps, applying on such land any spray material or bait and performing any other actions in accordance with section 52 of the Act which in the opinion of the authorised officer are necessary for the eradication or prevention or spread of the pest.
- (3) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, on instruction from an inspector, must strip fruit from trees, collect and dispose of waste fruit, or treat fruit and vegetables listed as hosts of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations in a manner approved by the Secretary.

**SPECIAL**

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- (4) Any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations which is transported through the restricted area, from areas free of Queensland Fruit Fly, must be transported in accordance with the conditions of a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.
  - (5) A person responsible for importing, introducing or bringing any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations into any part of Victoria from the restricted area is required to present the material for inspection, examination or treatment and the accompanying plant health certificate, assurance certificate, or plant health declaration for inspection and examination at a place prescribed in the Regulations or a place nominated by an inspector.

#### **Schedule 1**

The area of land bounded by a line commencing where the Nicholson River intersects the Victorian coastline, then in an easterly direction along the Victorian coastline to the intersection of the Victorian coastline and Bankins Road, then in a northerly direction along Bankins Road to the intersection of Bankins Road and Broadlands Street, then in a westerly direction along Broadlands Street to the intersection of Broadlands Street and Riverbank Road, then continuing in a straight line to Paynesville Road, then in a southerly direction along Paynesville Road to the intersection of Paynesville Road and Suding Road then in a westerly direction along Suding Road to the intersection of Suding Road and Bosworth Road, then in a westerly direction along Bosworth Road to the intersection of Bosworth Road and Collins Street, then in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the end of Dockertys Road, then in a westerly and northerly direction along Dockertys Road to the intersection of Dockertys Road and Wy Yung–Calulu Road, then in an easterly direction along Wy Yung–Calulu Road to the intersection of Wy Yung–Calulu Road and Fischers Lane, then in a northerly direction along Fischers Lane to the intersection of Fischers Lane and Mt Lookout Road, then in a north-westerly direction along Mt Lookout Road to the intersection of Mt Lookout Road and Mia Mia Road, then in a northerly direction along Mia Mia Road to the intersection of Mia Mia Road and Bullumwaal Road then in a southerly and then easterly direction along Bullumwaal Road to the intersection of Bullumwaal Road and Five Mile Track, then in a northerly direction along Five Mile Track to the intersection of Five Mile Track and Swamp Road, then in a north-easterly direction along Swamp Road to the intersection of Swamp Road and Howitt Spur Road then in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Atkinsons Road and the Nicholson River, then in a southerly direction along the Nicholson River to the point of commencement.

The area of land within a radius of one and a half kilometres of the affected property at 37.72722° South, 147.69083° East.

**1. Objective**

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly at Wangaratta and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

**2. Authorising provisions**

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

**3. Definition**

In this Order—

“**Act**” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**; and

“**Queensland Fruit Fly**” means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggart); and

“**Regulations**” mean the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

**4. Restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly**

#### Schedule 1

The area of land bounded by a line commencing where Boland Road intersects Federation Way, then in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Benton Road and Carraragarmungee Estate Road, then in a south-easterly direction along Carraragarmungee Estate Road to the intersection of Carraragarmungee Estate Road and Wangaratta–Eldorado Road, then in a southerly direction along Boralma–Tarrawingee Road, to the intersection of Boralma–Tarrawingee Road and Beechworth–Wangaratta Road, then in an easterly direction along Beechworth–Wangaratta Road to the intersection of Beechworth–Wangaratta Road and River Road, then in a southerly direction along River Road, which becomes Markwood–Tarrawingee Road to the intersection of Markwood–Tarrawingee Road and Milawa–Tarrawingee Road, then in a south-westerly direction along Milawa–Tarrawingee Road to the intersection of Milawa–Tarrawingee Road and Oxleys Flats Road, then in a south-easterly direction along Oxleys Flats Road to the intersection of Oxleys Flats Road and Factory Lane, then in a southerly direction along Factory Lane to the intersection of Factory Lane and Kerrs Road, then in a westerly direction along Kerrs Road to the intersection of Kerrs Road and Church Lane, then in a southerly direction along Church Lane to the intersection of Church Lane and Snow Road, then in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to the intersection of Oxley–Meadow Creek Road and Reillys Lane, then in a straight line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Wangaratta–Whitfield Road and Tetleys Lane, then in a westerly direction along Tetleys Lane to the intersection of Tetleys Lane and Oxley–Greta West Road, then in a south-westerly direction along Oxley–Greta West Road to the intersection of Oxley–Greta West Road and Alexanders Lane, then in a straight line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Twamleys Lane and Laceby–Glenrowan Road, then in a westerly direction along Laceby–Glenrowan Road to the intersection of Laceby–Glenrowan Road and Glenrowan–Moyhu Road, then in a north-westerly direction along Glenrowan–Moyhu Road to the intersection of Glenrowan–Moyhu Road and Gladstone Street, then in a westerly direction along Gladstone Street to the intersection of Gladstone Street and Beaconsfield Parade, then in a northerly direction along Beaconsfield Parade to the intersection of Beaconsfield Parade and Old Hume Highway, then in a westerly direction along Old Hume Highway to the intersection of Old Hume Highway and Upper Taminick Road, then in a north-westerly direction along Upper Taminick Road to the intersection of Upper Taminick Road and Sayers Road, then in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of Jones Road and Mount Bruno Road, then in a northerly direction along Mount Bruno Road to the intersection of Mount Bruno Road and Skeets Track, then in a north-easterly direction along Skeets Track to the intersection of Skeets Track and Adams Track, then in a north-easterly direction along Adams Track, which becomes Adams Road, which becomes Warby Tower Road to the intersection of Warby Tower Road and Wangaratta–Yarrowonga Road, then in a northerly direction along Wangaratta–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Wangaratta–Yarrowonga Road and Exchange Road, then in a straight line in an easterly direction to the intersection of Boorhaman Road and Naughtin Road, then in a north-easterly direction along Naughtin Road to the intersection of Naughtin Road and Back Estcourt Road, then in a south-easterly direction along Back Estcourt Road to the intersection of Back Estcourt Road and Boland Road, then in an easterly direction along Boland Road to the point of commencement.

#### Schedule 2

The area of land bounded by a line commencing where Phillipson Street intersects College Street, then in an easterly direction along College Street to the intersection of College Street and

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Ovens View Terrace, then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the intersection of Tweed Street and Burrows Street, then in an easterly direction along Burrows Street to the intersection of Burrows Street and Wangaratta Road, then in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Great Alpine Road and Porter Road, then in a straight line in a southerly direction to the end of Billabong Drive, then in a westerly direction along Billabong Drive to the intersection of Billabong Drive and Murdoch Road, then in a southerly direction along Murdoch Road to the intersection of Murdoch Road and Cribbes Road, then in a westerly direction along Cribbes Road, which becomes Mason Street to the intersection of Mason Street and Tavern Terrace, then in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the intersection of Parnell Court and Murrell Street, then in a westerly direction along Murrell Street to the intersection of Murrell Street and Tone Road, then in a north-easterly direction along Tone Road to the intersection of Tone Road and Henderson Street, then in a straight line in a northerly direction to the intersection of Frank Hayes Drive and Kerr Street, then in a northerly direction along Kerr Street to the intersection of Kerr Street and Sisely Avenue, then in a westerly direction along Sisely Avenue to the intersection of Sisely Avenue and Cruse Street, then in a north-westerly direction along Cruse Street to the intersection of Cruse Street and Three Mile Creek, then in a northerly direction along Three Mile Creek to the intersection of Three Mile Creek and Wangandary Road, then in an easterly direction along Wangandary Road to the intersection of Wangandary Road and the Wangaratta–Yarrowonga Road, then in an easterly direction along Wangaratta–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Wangaratta–Yarrowonga Road and College Street, then in an easterly direction along College Street to the point of commencement.

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
