Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that from 0000 hours on Friday 20 January 2006 until 2359 hours on Sunday 12 February 2006:

- bathing and the operation of vessels, excluding vessels authorised by the Manager Operations, Melbourne Stopover 2006 (or delegate) is prohibited within 200 metres of the vessels listed in Table 1 whilst underway within the Port of Port Phillip, excluding the waters of the Yarra River upstream of Beacons 23 and 24.
- (b) bathing and the operation of vessels, excluding vessels authorised by the Manager Operations, Melbourne Stopover 2006 (or delegate) is prohibited within 50 metres of the vessels listed in Table 1 whilst underway within the Yarra River upstream of Beacons 23 and 24.

Marine Act 1988 **SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the Marine Act 1988 that:

- Bathing and the operation of vessels is prohibited on the waters of Victoria Harbour within the area detailed in Table 1 at the times listed in Table 2, excluding those persons and vessels involved with the corresponding events and vessels authorised by the Manager Operations, Melbourne Stopover 2006 (or delegate).
- (2) the vessels involved with the events in the exclusion zones detailed in Table 2 of this Notice are excluded from Clauses 2(c), 3(a), 3(b) and 4(a) of Notice No.1 made under section 15(2) of the Marine Act 1988 for the times detailed in Table 2.
- At the completion of the event specified above, and as determined and announced by the (3) Manager Operations, Melbourne Stopover 2006 (or delegate), the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the Marine Act 1988.

Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:

- A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 37° 49.089' S 144° 56.091' E to a buoy located in approximate position 37°49.023' S 144° 56.375' E;
- A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 37°49.023' (b) S 144° 56.375' E to a buoy in approximate position 37° 49.152' S 144° 56.460' E;
- A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 37°48.152' S 144° (c) 56.460' E to a buoy in approximate position 37° 49.172' S 144° 56.406' E;
- A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 37°49.172' S 144° (d) 56.406' E to a buoy in approximate position 37° 49.109' S 144° 56.110'E;
- A line extending from a buoy located in approximate position 37°49.109' S 144° 56.110' E to a buoy in approximate position 37° 49.089' S 144° 56.091' E.
