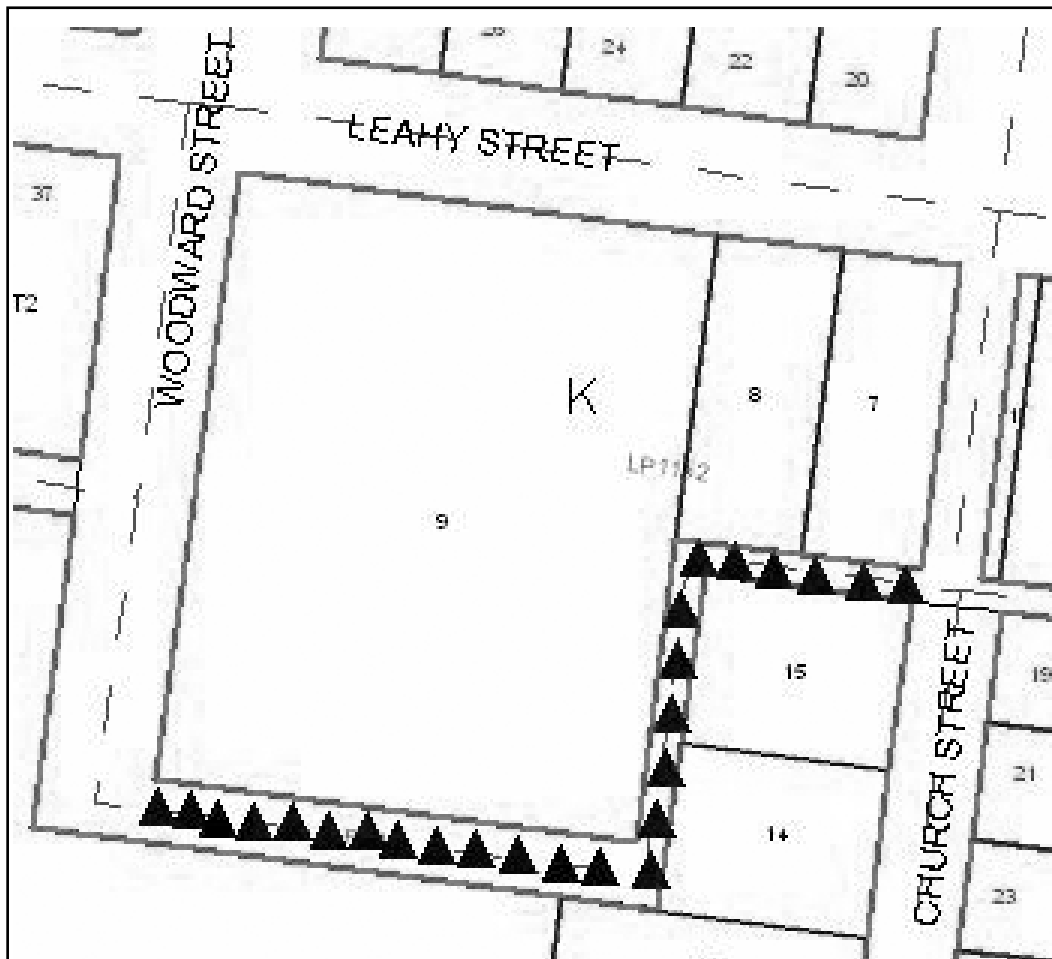

Dangerous Goods Act 1985

DANGEROUS GOODS (HCDG) REGULATIONS 2005

The Victorian WorkCover Authority issues the following approvals under sub-regulation (2) and (3) of Regulation 201 of the Dangerous Goods (HCDG) Regulations 2005.

These approvals relate to High Consequence Dangerous Goods (HCDG) which are ammonium nitrate emulsions and ammonium

nitrate mixtures containing greater than 45% ammonium nitrate and calcium ammonium nitrate (CAN) where the CAN solids, mixtures, blends or emulsions contain greater than 45% ammonium nitrate content.

A primary producer means any person engaged solely or substantially in agricultural, horticultural, viticultural, dairying, pastoral or like pursuits or any person being a commercial fisherman holding a licence to take fish for sale.

A secure store means a secure place where HCDG is kept under lock and key or is under constant surveillance, and where there are procedures for—

- a. controlling access to the store or site; and
- b. secure control of keys to the store or site; and
- c. documenting the dispatching and receiving of measured quantities of HCDG.

A nonstop journey means journey undertaken on a public highway or waterway transporting HCDG from one secure store or secure site to another or to a site where it is to be used during which the HCDG is kept under constant surveillance.

1. Secondary and tertiary education institutions being:
 - a. a State School as defined in the **Education Act 1985**,
 - b. a non-government school registered by the Registered Schools Board,
 - c. an institution of tertiary education or University registered by the Office of Training and Tertiary Education of the Victorian Department of Education and Training, and
 - d. public Universities, and laboratories that use HCDG for the purposes of educational instruction, research or testing, are not required to hold a licence to store, use, handle, dispose of or transport up to 3 kilograms of HCDG provided the material is kept in a secure store when not actually being used.
2. Any person authorised to have access to HCDG is not required to hold an additional licence to transport up to 20 kilograms of HCDG provided they transport it in a nonstop journey.

3. Primary producers who hold a primary producer licence for HCDG are not required to hold an additional licence to transport up to 5 tonnes of HCDG provided they transport it in a nonstop journey.
4. Primary producers who hold a primary producer licence for HCDG are not required to hold an additional licence to transport any quantity of HCDG to which the licence relates across a public highway which divides the property from one part of the property, specified on a primary producer licence to another part.
5. Members of the Victoria Police, Fire Authorities or other Emergency Service personnel acting under the direction of their organisation are not required to hold a licence to transport any quantity of HCDG providing it is for the purpose of protecting people from injury or property from damage.
