Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (1) bathing and the operation of vessels is prohibited on the waters of Victoria Harbour within the areas detailed in Table 2 and at the times as specified in Table 1 excluding those persons and vessels involved in the events and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria.
- (2) At the completion of the event specified above, and as determined and announced by the Parks Victoria Ranger in Charge Yarra River, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act** 1988.

Area A The waters bounded by: A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 60 metres south-east of Dopel Way to a red buoy located approximately 50 metres south-west of the north-eastern corner of New Quay. A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 50 metres south-west (b) of the north-eastern corner of New Ouay to a red buoy located approximately 30 metres north-west of the eastern end of Berth 14 Central Pier. A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 30 metres north-west (c) of the eastern end of Berth 14 Central Pier to a red buoy located approximately 50 metres north-east of the western end of Berth 13 Central Pier. (d) A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 50 metres north-east of the western end of Berth 13 Central Pier to a red buoy located approximately 60 metres south-east of Dopel Way.

SPECIAL

Area B The waters bounded by: A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 60 metres south-west of Dopel Way to a red buoy located approximately 55 metres south-east of St Mangos Lane. (b) A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 55 metres south-east of St Mangos Lane to a red buoy located approximately 60 metres north-west of the eastern end of Berth 13 Central Pier. A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 60 metres north-west (c) of the eastern end of Berth 13 Central Pier to a red buoy located approximately 100 metres north-west of the western end of Berth 13 Central Pier. A line extending from a red buoy located approximately 100 metres nort-west (d) of the western end of Berth 13 Central Pier to a red buoy located approximately 60 metres south-east of Dopel Way.

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under sub-section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- (a) bathing and the operation of vessels are prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River between an imaginary line from downstream edge of the VRA Landing and the upstream edge Federation Wharf to the upstream edge of Bridge Road Bridge between the hours of 12 midday and 5.30 p.m. on 25 November 2006, excluding vessels involved with the Head of Yarra Rowing Regatta and vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria.
- (b) The vessels involved with the Head of the Yarra Rowing Regatta are excluded from Clauses 3(a), 3(b) and 7 of Notice No. 1 made under s.15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the period specified above.
- (c) At the completion of the event and as determined and announced by the Parks Victoria Ranger in Charge Yarra River, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 made under sub-section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
