FISHERIES (ABALONE VIRUS) NOTICE NO. 10/2006

1. Title

This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Abalone Virus) Notice No. 10/2006.

2. Objectives

The objective of this Notice is to manage the spread of herpes-like virus of abalone.

3. Authorising provision

This Notice is made under sections 67, 114 and 152 of the Fisheries Act 1995.

4. Commencement

This Notice comes into operation on 16 December 2006.

5. Definitions

In this Notice -

"shellfish" means all species in the phylum mollusca except squid, octopus and cuttlefish;

"substrate" means any part of the sea bed and sub-soil lying beneath the waters;


"the Act" means the Fisheries Act 1995.

- 6. Prohibitions
 - (1) For the purpose of section 67 of the Act, the taking or possession of the following fish is prohibited in the area described in the Schedule
 - (a) abalone and any other shellfish;
 - (b) sea urchins.
 - (2) Despite sub-clause (1) a person may possess abalone in the area described in the schedule if the person is travelling by boat by the shortest practicable route from a point outside that area to the mouth of the Moyne River.
 - (3) For the purpose of section 114 of the Act, the use of commercial abalone equipment is prohibited in the area described in the Schedule.
 - (4) A person must not collect any substrate from the area described in the Schedule. Penalty: 50 Penalty units.
 - (5) This clause does not apply to a person authorised by the Secretary to undertake activities within the area described in the Schedule.
- 7. Revocation

Unless sooner revoked, this Fisheries Notice will be automatically revoked on the 31 March 2007.

Schedule

An area along the Victorian coastline west of Port Fairy that includes marine waters. The area is bounded by the high water mark from Point 1 (approximately 1 kilometre west of Craggs Car Park) to Point 6 (Killarney Beach Car Park) and includes an area of marine waters within the lines joining the following points as shown on the attached map:



Western Boundary is approximately 1 kilometre west of the Craggs Car Park

Eastern Boundary is the Killarney Beach Car Park.

FISHERIES (GIPPSLAND LAKES BREAM) NOTICE NO. 11/2006

1. Title

This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Gippsland Lakes Bream) Notice No. 11/2006

2. Objectives

The objective of this Notice is to apply increased restrictions on commercial and recreational fishing for bream in the Gippsland Lakes to protect breeding stocks in those waters.

3. Authorising provision

This Notice is made under section 152(1)(aa) of the Fisheries Act 1995.

4. Commencement

This Notice comes into operation on 18 December 2006.

5. Size Limit

For the purposes of section 68A(3) of the **Fisheries Act 1995**, the minimum size for taking or possessing bream from the Gippsland Lakes or any of its tributaries is 28 centimetres.

Note: It is an offence under section 68A(3)(a) for a person to take or have in his or her possession fish that are less than the minimum size specified by the regulations or by a fisheries notice for that species of fish. The penalty for that offence is 20 penalty units (currently \$2,148).

6. Revocation

Unless sooner revoked, this Notice will be automatically revoked 12 months after the day on which this fisheries notice commences.
