## Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995

### ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA NEAR BAROOGA (NSW) FOR THE CONTROL OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

**1. Objective**

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly in Victoria, near Barooga (NSW) and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

**2. Authorising provisions**

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

**3. Definition**

In this Order—

“**Act**” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**; and

“**Queensland Fruit Fly**” means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggatt); and

“**Regulations**” mean the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

**4. Restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly**

The restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly is declared to be the area described in Schedule 1.

**5. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements**

- (1) The removal from the restricted area into any part of Victoria of any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations is prohibited unless the fruit or vegetable is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate, Assurance Certificate or Plant Health Declaration, and in the case of fruit for treatment, packing or processing outside the restricted area, is accompanied by a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.
- (2) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2 must give access to such land at all times to an inspector, after 24 hours notice is given to the occupier or if the occupier consents to the entry, for the purpose of inspection, placing on such land any lures or traps, applying on such land any spray material or bait and performing any other actions in accordance with the Act which in the opinion of the authorised officer are necessary for the eradication or prevention or spread of the pest.
- (3) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, on instruction from an inspector, must strip fruit from trees, collect and dispose of waste fruit, or treat fruit and vegetables listed as hosts of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations in a manner approved by the Secretary.
- (4) Any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations which is transported through the restricted area, from areas free of Queensland Fruit Fly, must be transported in accordance with the conditions of a permit issued by an inspector under section 21 of the Act.

**SPECIAL**

- (5) A person responsible for importing, introducing or bringing any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland Fruit Fly in Schedule 5 of the Regulations into any part of Victoria from the restricted area is required to present the material for inspection, examination or treatment and the accompanying plant health certificate, assurance certificate, or plant health declaration for inspection and examination at a place prescribed in the Regulations or a place nominated by an inspector.

#### **Schedule 1**

The area of land bounded by a line commencing where the Murray River intersects Dead River Track, then in a south-westerly direction along Dead River Track to the intersection of Dead River Track and the Murray Valley Highway, then in a south-easterly direction along the Murray Valley Highway to the intersection of the Murray Valley Highway and Grinter Track, then in a southerly direction along Grinter Track to the intersection of Grinter Track and O'Brien Road, then in a westerly direction along O'Brien Road to the intersection of O'Brien Road and Yourang Road, then in a southerly direction along Yourang Road to the intersection of Yourang Road and Powerline Road, then in a westerly direction along Powerline Road to the intersection of Powerline Road and Katamatite School Road, then in a southerly direction along Katamatite School Road to the intersection of Katamatite School Road and Cassidy Road, then in a westerly direction along Cassidy Road to the intersection of Cassidy Road and Benalla–Tocumwal Road, then in a north-easterly direction along Benalla–Tocumwal Road to the intersection of Benalla–Tocumwal Road and Ross Road, then in a westerly direction along Ross Road to the intersection of Ross Road and McPhersons Road, then in a northerly direction along McPhersons Road to the intersection of McPhersons Road and Sandmount Road, then in a westerly direction along Sandmount Road to the intersection of Sandmount Road and Tobruk Road, then in a northerly direction along Tobruk Road to the intersection of Tobruk Road and Blamey Road, then in a westerly direction along Blamey Road to the intersection of Blamey Road and Larissa Road, then in a northerly direction along Larissa Road to the intersection of Larissa Road and Churchill Road, then in a westerly direction along Churchill Road to the intersection of Churchill Road and Singapore Road, then in a northerly direction along Singapore Road to the intersection of Singapore Road and the Murray Valley Highway, then in an easterly direction along the Murray Valley Highway to the intersection of the Murray Valley Highway and the Goulburn Valley Highway, then in a north-westerly direction along the Goulburn Valley Highway to the intersection of the Goulburn Valley Highway and Maidment Road, then in a westerly direction along Maidment Road to the intersection of Maidment Road and Naughton Road, then in a northerly direction along Naughton Road to the intersection of Naughton Road and Mywee Road, then in a south-easterly direction along Mywee Road to the intersection of Mywee Road and the Goulburn Valley Highway, then in a northerly direction along the Goulburn Valley Highway to the intersection of the Goulburn Valley Highway and Torgannah Road, then in a northerly direction along Torgannah Road to the intersection of Torgannah Road and Murray Road, then in a straight line in a northerly direction to the Murray River, then in a south-easterly direction along the Murray River to the point of commencement.

#### **Schedule 2**

The part of land within Victoria of the area of land within a radius of one and a half kilometres of the property at 35.90692° South, 145.697985° East.
