Border between New South Wales
and Victoria from Cape Howe
to the nearest source of the Murray River

Black-Allan Line

I, John Landy AC, MBE, Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Premier, in accordance with section 87E(b) of the Constitution Act 1975, hereby acknowledge that the Black–Allan Line is the demarked boundary between New South Wales and Victoria from Cape Howe to the nearest source of the Murray River as described respectively in the Plan of "Trig: Survey No. 11 Sheets 1–5" held in the Plan Room, Department of Lands, Sydney, New South Wales and Plans "BL1A, BL2A–8A" held in the Central Plan Office, Department of Sustainability and Environment, Melbourne, Victoria.
