Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995

ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA AT TUNGAMAH FOR THE CONTROL OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

1. Objective

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly at Tungamah, and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

2. Authorising provisions

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. Definition

In this Order—

“Act” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**; and

“Queensland fruit fly” means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggatt); and

“Queensland fruit fly host material” means any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland fruit fly in Schedule 5 of the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

4. Restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly

The restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly is declared to be the area described in Schedule 1.

5. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements

- (1) This order does not apply to Queensland fruit fly host material grown within the restricted area if accompanied by –
 - (a) an assurance certificate issued by a person who is accredited by the Department of Primary Industries; or
 - (b) a plant health certificate issued by an authorised inspector – certifying that the Queensland fruit fly host material has been treated in a manner approved by the Manager Plant Standards.
- (2) The removal from the restricted area into any part of Victoria of any Queensland fruit fly host material is prohibited.
- (3) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2 must give access to such land at all times to an inspector, after 24 hours notice is given to the occupier or if the occupier consents to the entry, for the purpose of inspection, placing on such land any lures or traps, applying on such land any spray material or bait and performing any other actions in accordance with the Act which in the opinion of the inspector are necessary for the eradication or prevention of the spread of the pest.
- (4) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, on instruction from an inspector, must strip Queensland Fruit Fly host materials from plants, collect and dispose of waste material, or treat the material in a manner approved by the Manager Plant Standards.

Schedule 1

The area of land bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the Benalla–Tocumwal Road and Oliver Road, then heading in an easterly direction along Oliver Road to the intersection of Oliver Road and Benalla–Yarrowonga Road, then in a northerly direction along Benalla–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Benalla–Yarrowonga Road and Wangaratta Road, then in an easterly direction along Wangaratta Road to the intersection of Wangaratta Road and Howells Road, then in a northerly direction along Howells Road to the intersection of Howells Road and Willis Road, then in an easterly direction along Willis Road to the intersection of Willis Road and Burns Road, then in a northerly direction along Burns Road to the intersection of Burns Road and Almonds Road, then in an easterly, then northerly direction along Almonds Road, which becomes Martins Road to the intersection of Martins Road and Hammons Road, then in a westerly direction along Hammons Road to the intersection of Hammons Road and Yarrowonga–Wilby Road then in a northerly direction along Yarrowonga–Wilby Road to the intersection of Yarrowonga–Wilby Road and Lavis Road, then in a westerly direction along Lavis Road to the intersection of Lavis Road and Benalla–Yarrowonga Road, then in a northerly direction along Benalla–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Benalla–Yarrowonga Road and Beatties Road, then in a westerly direction along Beatties Road to the intersection of Beatties Road and Brownings Road, then in a northerly direction along Brownings Road to the intersection of Brownings Road and Dodds Road, then in a westerly direction along Dodds Road to the intersection of Dodds Road and Telford–Yarrowonga Road, then in a northerly direction along Telford–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Telford–Yarrowonga Road and Katamatite–Yarrowonga Road, then in a westerly direction along Katamatite–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Katamatite–Yarrowonga Road and Connell Road and O’Dwyer Road, then in a southerly direction along O’Dwyer Road to the intersection of O’Dwyer Road and Katamatite–Yarrowonga Road, then in a westerly direction along Katamatite–Yarrowonga Road to the intersection of Katamatite–Yarrowonga Road and Grinter Road, then in a southerly direction along Grinter Road to the intersection of Grinter Road and Hopkins Road, then in a westerly direction along Hopkins Road to the intersection of Hopkins Road and Youarang Road, then in a southerly direction along Youarang Road to the intersection of Youarang Road and Telford Road, then in a westerly direction along Telford Road to the intersection of Telford Road and Okane Road, then in a southerly direction along Okane Road to the intersection of Okane Road and Wallden Road, then in a westerly direction along Wallden Road to the intersection of Wallden Road and Mills Road, then in a southerly direction along Mills Road to the intersection of Mills Road and Carmody Road, then in a westerly, then southerly direction along Carmody Road, which becomes Yabba Road, to the intersection of Yabba Road and Gawne Road, then in a southerly direction along Gawne Road to the intersection of Gawne Road and Katandra Road, then in an easterly direction along Katandra Road to the intersection of Katandra Road and Evans Road, then in a southerly direction along Evans Road to the intersection of Evans Road and Mahoney Road, then in an easterly direction along Mahoney Road to the intersection of Mahoney Road and Fyffe Road, then in a southerly direction along Fyffe Road to the intersection of Fyffe Road and Waggarrandall Road, then in an easterly direction along Waggarrandall Road to the intersection of Waggarrandall Road and Benalla–Tocumwal Road, then in a south easterly direction along Benalla–Tocumwal Road to the point of commencement.

Schedule 2

The area of land in Victoria within a radius of one and a half kilometres of the outbreak epicentre at 145.87806° East, 36.16389° South.
