ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA AT BAIRNSDALE FOR THE CONTROL OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY

I, Bob Cameron, Minister for Agriculture, under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** make the following Order declaring a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly and specifying the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

1. Objective

The objective of this Order is to declare a restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly at Bairnsdale, and to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in the restricted area.

2. Authorising provisions

This Order is made under sections 20 and 22 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. Definition

In this Order-

“**Act**” means the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**; and

“**Queensland fruit fly**” means the exotic pest *Bactrocera tryoni* (Froggatt); and

“**Queensland fruit fly host material**” means any fruit or vegetable listed as a host of Queensland fruit fly in Schedule 5 of the Plant Health and Plant Products Regulations 1996.

4. Restricted area for the control of Queensland fruit fly

The restricted area for the control of Queensland Fruit Fly is declared to be the area described in Schedule 1.

5. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements

(1) This order does not apply to Queensland fruit fly host material grown within the restricted area if accompanied by –

(a) an assurance certificate issued by a person who is accredited by the Department of Primary Industries; or

(b) a plant health certificate issued by an authorised inspector –

certifying that the Queensland fruit fly host material has been treated in a manner approved by the Manager Plant Standards.

(2) The removal from the restricted area into any part of Victoria of any Queensland fruit fly host material is prohibited.

(3) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2 must give access to such land at all times to an inspector, after 24 hours notice is given to the occupier or if the occupier consents to the entry, for the purpose of inspection, placing on such land any lures or traps, applying on such land any spray material or bait and performing any other actions in accordance with the Act which in the opinion of the inspector are necessary for the eradication or prevention of the spread of the pest.

SPECIAL

- (4) The owners and occupiers of land described in Schedule 2, on instruction from an inspector, must strip Queensland Fruit Fly host materials from plants, collect and dispose of waste material, or treat the material in a manner approved by the Manager Plant Standards.

Schedule 1

The area of land bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the Princes Highway and Scotts Lane, then heading in a northerly direction along Scotts Lane to the intersection of Scotts Lane and Baudinets Road, then in a westerly direction along Baudinets Road to the intersection of Baudinets Road and Lindenow–Glenaladale Road, then in a northerly direction along Lindenow–Glenaladale Road to the intersection of Lindenow–Glenaladale Road and Rodericks Road, then in a northerly direction along Rodericks Road to the intersection of Rodericks Road and Flaggy Creek Road, then in an easterly direction along Flaggy Creek Road to the intersection of Flaggy Creek Road and Williams Road, then in a northerly direction along Williams Road to the intersection of Williams Road and Melwood Boundary Track, then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the intersection of Tower Road and Laytons Road, then in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to the intersection of Orrs Road and Deptford Road, then in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Great Alpine Road and School Road, then in a southerly direction along School Road, which becomes Sarsfield Road, to the intersection of Sarsfield Road and Princes Highway, then in a westerly direction along Princes Highway to the intersection of Princes Highway and Morrison Road, then in a southerly direction along Morrison Road to the intersection of Morrison Road and Broadlands Street, then in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the intersection of Waterview Road and Paynesville Road, then in an easterly direction along Paynesville Road to the intersection of Paynesville Road and Newlands Drive, then in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to the intersection of Dawsons Cove Drive and Colony Club Drive, then in a north-westerly direction along Colony Club Drive to the intersection of Colony Club Drive and Lake Fair Rise, then in a south-westerly direction along Lake Fair Rise to the intersection of Lake Fair Rise and Outlook Avenue then in a north-westerly direction along Outlook Avenue to the intersection of Outlook Avenue and Crown Ridge Avenue, then in a south-westerly direction along Crown Ridge Avenue to the intersection of Crown Ridge Avenue and Meridian Way, then in a southerly direction along Meridian Way to the intersection of Meridian Way and Birrells Road, then in a westerly direction along Birrells Road, which becomes Peecks Road, to the intersection of Peecks Road and Ramowi Road, then in a straight line in a westerly direction to the intersection of Goon Nure Road and Leathams Road, then in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the point of commencement.

Schedule 2

The area of land in Victoria within a radius of one and a half kilometres of the outbreak epicentre at 147.60413° East, 37.81914° South.

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
