

# Pharmacy Practice Act 2004

The Pharmacy Board of Victoria at a formal hearing conducted on 3 March 2006 found that Andrew John Wells, registered number 10155, had engaged in unprofessional conduct of a serious nature pursuant to Section 69(1)(a) of the **Pharmacy Practice Act 2004**.

The panel made the following determinations:

- (a) pursuant to Section 69(2)(c), reprimands Andrew John Wells;
- (b) pursuant to Section 69(2)(e), imposes the following conditions upon the registration of Andrew John Wells:
  - that he continue treatment by a drug and alcohol specialist medical practitioner approved by the Pharmacy Board who is to provide medical reports to the Registrar at not less than two monthly intervals;
  - that he continue random urinary drug screens at not less than fortnightly intervals, the results of which are to be forwarded to the Registrar;
  - that he continue to attend counselling and self-help group sessions as directed by the drug and alcohol specialist medical practitioner;
  - that he will not practise as a pharmacist for more than forty hours in any week and eight hours in any one day;
  - that he will not work as the sole pharmacist on duty at any time;
  - that he will not have possession of the keys to any pharmacy or pharmacy department and not enter or be on the premises of any pharmacy or pharmacy department unless another pharmacist is present;
  - that he work under the supervision of a workplace monitor who is fully informed of the conditions placed on his registration and who will forward monthly reports to the Registrar on his work performance and conduct, and for the workplace monitor to report immediately any unusual or aberrant behaviour or misuse of drugs to the Registrar; and
  - these conditions to remain in force unless varied by the Board.
- (c) pursuant to Section 69(2)(h), suspends the registration of Andrew John Wells for a period of six months effective from the notification of this determination; and

(d) pursuant to Section 69(2)(j), requires Andrew John Wells to pay the reasonable costs and expenses of the Board in the conduct of the hearing which were agreed to be \$8,164.75.

Mr Wells lodged an application for review of the finding and determination to the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal which was subsequently withdrawn on 21 April 2006.

The determination is effective from 27 April 2006.

# Water Act 1989 BY-LAW NO. 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS FOR DROUGHT RESPONSE

Lower Murray Water (LMW) is to introduce a revised By-Law No. 2, Water Restrictions for Drought Response, for all urban and rural garden water supply systems across the LMW region from 1 July 2006, as required and outlined in Action 5.8 of the government's White Paper for Water.

Water shortages across the state led to the development of By-Law No. 2 Restrictions for Drought Response and the intent of the By-Law is to ensure greater uniformity by introducing a four stage uniform restriction schedule across the State of Victoria.

By-Law No. 2 Restrictions for Drought Response will replace By-Law No. 2 Permanent Conservation and Demand Management Restrictions.

Key elements of By-Law No. 2 Water Restrictions for Drought Response:

- Replacing the five stage restriction schedule with a state wide uniform four stage restriction schedule.
- Increase in the number of restriction categories from fourteen to twenty-four.
- Improvement and an increase in the number of definitions.
- A listing of "Trigger Points" for all four restriction stages.
- The provision of a key word index for ease of restriction schedule access.

#### PERMANENT WATER SAVING PLAN

Lower Murray Water (LMW) is to introduce permanent water saving rules for all urban and rural garden water supply systems across the LMW region from 1 July 2006, as required and outlined in Action 5.4 of the government's White Paper for Water and pursuant to the **Water Act 1989** Section 170A to G.

Water shortages across the state led to the development of a Permanent Water Saving Plan and it is important that these new water saving rules, which will be imposed by all Water Authorities, are easily understood and readily adopted by our customers.

Key elements of the Permanent Water Saving Plan include:

- Changes in the time-of-use for both automatic and manual watering systems. These include private/public gardens and lawns, and public sports and recreational grounds.
- Fountains may only be used if they recirculate water.
- A hand-held hose must not be used at any time to clean a vehicle unless it is fitted with a trigger nozzle.
- Hard surfaces must not be cleaned with water from a hose unless cleaning is required as a result of an accident, fire, emergency or a health hazard has developed.
- No restrictions apply to watering of plants at wholesale, retail and municipal garden nurseries.

Hoses used in the construction industry must be fitted with a trigger nozzle.




