NOTICE OF DECISION

Land Regulations 2006

I, Rob Hulls, Minister for Planning and Minister responsible for administering the **Land Act 1958**, give notice under section 12 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** as follows:

A Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) was prepared in relation to the proposed Land Regulations 2006. The objectives of the proposed Regulations are to:

- (a) restrict the activities of members of the public on licensed water frontages;
- (b) prescribe fees and forms for the purposes of the Act;
- (c) provide for the issue of duplicate documents;
- (d) provide for other matters for the purposes of the Act.

The RIS was advertised seeking public comment and four submissions were received.

After considering the submissions received, I have decided that the proposed Regulations should be made without amendment.
