Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that, for the periods and locations outlined below, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the Community Safety Day, are prohibited on the following waters of the Yarra River:

- (a) the waters of Victoria Harbour within the area detailed in Table 1 from 9.00 am until 4.00 pm on 28 October 2007

Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone for the purpose of the Community Safety Day

The waters bounded by:
(i) a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 5.3040" S, 144° 56' 10.0716" E to a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 1.3800" S, 144° 56' 24.1044" E;
(ii) a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 1.3800" S, 144° 56' 24.1044" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 7.0680" S, 144° 56' 25.9908" E;
(iii) a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 7.0680" S, 144° 56' 25.9908" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 8.0400" S, 144° 56' 13.0632" E;
(iv) a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 8.0400" S, 144° 56' 13.0632" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 5.3040" S, 144° 56' 10.0716" E.

- (b) The vessels involved with the Community Safety Day are excluded from clauses 2(a), 2(c), 3(a), 3(b), 7 and 12 of Notice No.1 made under s.15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the date and times detailed above.
- (c) All operators and occupants of vessels propelled by paddle or oar and operated by Lifesaving Victoria, and involved in the event, are exempt from PFD wearing requirements specified in Regulation 232 provided supervision of participants and appropriate rescue service is provided.
- (d) At the completion of the event and as determined and announced by the Parks Victoria Ranger in Charge Yarra River, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No.1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
