Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of the Strathbogie Shire Council, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that for the periods and times listed in the table below, the operation of vessels is prohibited on the waters of Lake Nagambie south east of an imaginary line between the waters edge adjacent to the prolongation of Racecourse Road and the northern point of Vickers Island excluding –

- (a) vessels involved with the events listed in the Table of this Notice; and
- (b) vessels operated by the Shire of Strathbogie; and
- (c) vessels launching from and returning to the Nagambie Lake Leisure Park boat ramp and adjacent foreshore providing that they;
 - (i) travel directly to and from the Goulburn River entrance north of Vickers Island; and
 - (ii) travel to the west of Dellah Island; and
 - (iii) not exceed 5 knots on the above waters on Lake Nagambie.

**Marine Act 1988****SECTION 15 NOTICE**

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Acting Senior Sergeant Steven Towers, a member of Victoria Police, hereby

1. give notice under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** that –
 - (a) vessels involved with the Lifesaving Victoria carnival series and Inflatable Rescue Boat Premiership Series, being held at the times, dates and locations outlined below in Table 1 are excluded from Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 4(a) of Notice No.1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

and are subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The exemption will be automatically suspended for any periods when swimmers or other vessels not associated with the event approach within 200 metres;
- (ii) The above provisions will apply only to operators and vessels associated with the event in a list maintained by Lifesaving Victoria.
