NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF A REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Transport (Taxi-Cabs) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 Transport (Passenger Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2007

Notice is given under section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Transport (Taxi-Cabs) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and Transport (Passenger Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2007.

The objectives of the proposed Regulations are to:

- (a) prescribe vision acuteness tests for persons who apply to be accredited to drive commercial passenger vehicles;
- (b) prescribe who may certify the medical condition of persons who apply to be accredited to drive commercial passenger vehicles;
- (c) require drivers of taxi-cabs to display a photo card; and
- (d) prohibit operators of commercial passenger vehicles from allowing unaccredited persons to drive the vehicle.

The substance of these provisions is not new. They repeat current provisions in the context of recent changes to the **Transport Act 1983**.

The RIS discusses the likely impact of the proposed Regulations, assesses the benefits and costs of the proposed Regulations and discusses possible alternative means of achieving the stated objectives. The RIS concludes that the benefits of the proposed Regulations outweigh the expected costs.

Please note that all comments and submissions will be treated as public documents.
