ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER (NO. 194) 2007

The Governor in Council makes the following Order:

1. Title

This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 194) 2007.

2. Authorising provisions

This Order is made under sections 3 and 5 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983.

3. Operation and effect of Order

- (1) Subject to sub-clause (2), this Order takes effect on 5 December 2006.
- (2) In relation to items 5 to 7 in the Schedule, this Order takes effect on 26 March 2007.
- (3) This Order has effect despite anything to the contrary in Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 192) 2006 or Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 193) 2007.

4. Definitions

In this Order—

"Body" means Minister, Department or officer;

"instrument" includes contract and agreement;

"Old Body" means a Body specified in Column 1 of an item in the Schedule;

"New Body" means a Body specified in Column 3 of an item in the Schedule;

"Schedule" means Schedule to this Order;

"transaction" includes—

- (a) agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement; and
- (b) action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding; and
- (c) assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property; and
- (d) loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money; and
- (e) approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, order, permit, requirement or other authority; and
- (f) notice; and
- (g) any other act, entitlement or liability at law.

5. Construction of references

In respect of each item in the Schedule, a reference to an Old Body—

- (a) in a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or
- (b) in a statutory instrument or other instrument made under an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or

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(c) in respect of any other matter or thing done under a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule—

is deemed to be a reference to the New Body.

6. Saving of existing transactions

If a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body before the day on which this Order has effect in relation to an item—

- (a) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction; and
- (b) the transaction shall continue in the same way it would have continued if this Order had not been made; and
- (c) the transaction may be given effect to, or enforced or completed, by the New Body in the same way as it would have been given effect to, or enforced or completed, by the Old Body as if this Order had not been made.

7. Keeping financial accounts and reports

The Secretary to the Department of Education must ensure that financial accounts are kept and reports are provided for the purposes of the **Financial Management Act 1994** until 31 December 2006 in respect of a function under an Act specified in items 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the Schedule that is transferred from the Old Body specified in that item to the New Body specified in that item as if the function had not been transferred.

8. Providing financial accounts and reports

A Secretary to a Department to which a function is transferred must, if requested by a Secretary to a Department referred to in clause 7, provide the Secretary referred to in clause 7 with any financial accounts and records or other information required to enable the Secretary referred to in clause 7 to comply with clause 7.
