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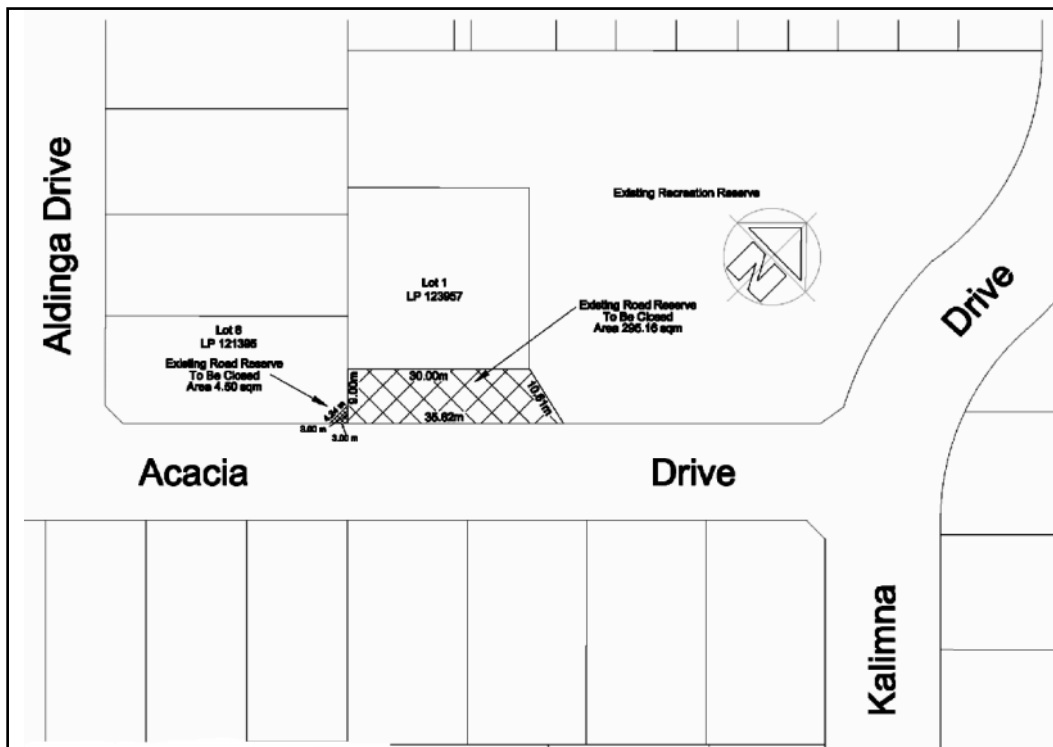

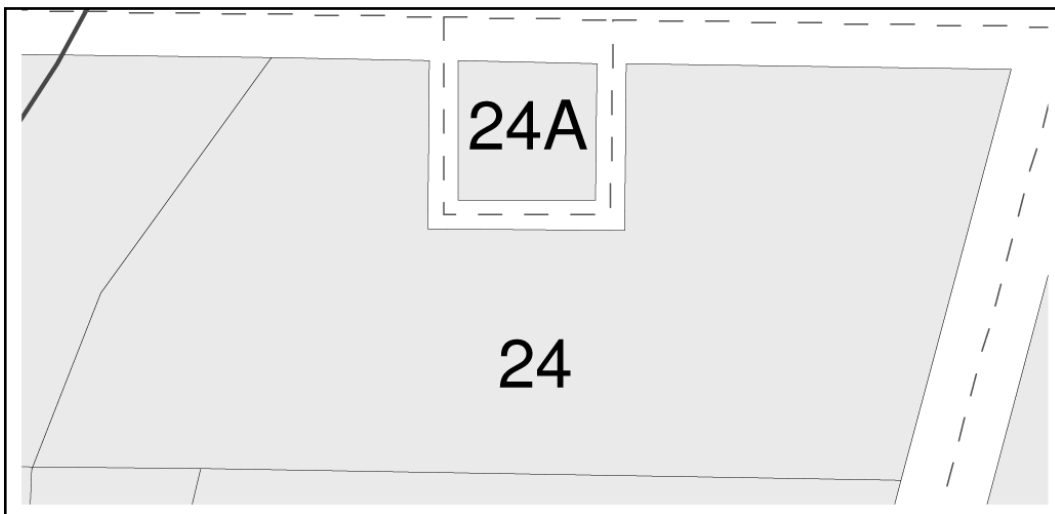




Road Discontinuance

New Meeting Procedure Local Law

Notice is hereby given that the City of Boroondara, at its meeting held on 26 March 2007, resolved to adopt its new Meeting Procedure Local Law, entitled Meeting Procedure Local Law, which repeals the existing Meeting Procedure Local Law No. 3a in its entirety and replaces it with this Local Law titled Meeting Procedure Local Law.

The purpose of the Local Law is to:

- provide for the election of the Mayor;
- regulate the use of the common seal;
- prohibit unauthorised use of the common seal or any device resembling the common seal; and
- provide for the procedures governing the conduct of Council meetings and Special Committee Meetings.

The general purport of the Meeting Procedure Local Law will be to:

- revoke the existing Meeting Procedure Local Law No. 3a in its entirety;
- establish a law which will govern order of business, rules of debate, meeting procedure, public access and conduct of meetings; and
- improve and formalise governance processes when dealing with public submissions and presentations at Special Committee meetings.

This Local Law will come into effect from 6 April 2007.

#### Notice of Intention to Make a Local Law

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 119 of the **Local Government Act 1989** that Swan Hill Rural City Council at its Ordinary Meeting held on 20 February 2007 resolved to intend to make a new Local Law entitled Local Law No. 2 – Community.

The purpose and general purport of the proposed Local Law No. 2 is to:

- a. provide for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district;
- b. provide a safe and healthy environment, in which the residents of the municipal district enjoy a quality of life that meets the general expectations of the community;
- c. control and regulate emissions to the air in order to improve the amenity, environment and quality of life in the municipal district;
- d. ensure that the public can properly use and enjoy public reserves by regulating activities and behaviour in public reserves;

- e. prohibit, regulate and control the consumption of alcohol in designated areas within the municipal district;
- f. manage, regulate and control the different uses to which streets, roads, footpaths and Council land can be put so as to ensure that there is a proper balance between private uses and the need to maintain freedom of movement for the public; and
- g. manage, regulate and control the keeping of animals and birds.

The new law integrates and codifies the previous Local Laws:

- a. No. 2 Consumption of Liquor in Public Places;
- b. No. 5 Keeping of Animals, Birds and Poultry; and
- c. No. 6 Streets and Roads

which it is proposed that on adoption of Local Law No. 2 – Community, shall be revoked.

The Local Law No. 2 also incorporates by reference:

- a. the Waste Code of Practice, which has the objective of providing an environment where activity related to waste and recycling complement the safety, & amenity of the community.
- b. Building and Works Code of Practice, which has the objective of providing an environment where activity on and related to building sites and building works complement the safety and amenity of the public and the community.
- c. Trading Code of Practice which has the objective of providing for the peace, order, well being and safety of people and amenity of public places in the municipality
- d. Livestock Code of Practice which has the objective of:
  - i. ensuring safety of the public, farmers and stock on Council controlled roads;
  - ii. aims to prevent damage to the road structure and environs; and
  - iii. promotes the conservation of flora and fauna on roadside land.

In accordance with Section 223 of the **Local Government Act 1989**, written submissions may be made by any person affected by the proposed Local Law. Any person making a submission may request to be heard in support of their submission at a meeting of the Council. Where a person wishes to be heard by Council they must advise of such in their written submission. ## Order in Council

The Governor in Council makes the following Order:

**Objective**

1. The objective of this Order is to authorise, subject to conditions, the taking, keeping and selling of certain protected aquatic biota.

**Authorising provision**

2. This Order is made under section 73 of the **Fisheries Act 1995**.

**Commencement**

3. This Order comes into operation on the day on which it is published in the Victorian Government Gazette.

**Definitions**

4. In this Order, “syngnathids” means the taxa of Family *Syngnathidae* (all species including seahorses, seadragons and pipefish).

**Authorisation to sell syngnathids**

5. A person may sell syngnathids provided that the person –
  - (a) before selling the syngnathids, creates a document concerning the proposed sale which contains the following information –
    - (i) the name and address of seller;
    - (ii) the date of the sale;
    - (iii) the species of syngnathid;
    - (iv) the quantity of individual species of syngnathids sold;
    - (v) a unique identifying number generated from a sequential system of numbering the record of the sale; and
  - (b) in the case of a sale of syngnathids by consignment, ensures that a copy of the document accompanies the consignment; and
  - (c) in the case of any other sale, ensures that a copy of the document is given to the purchaser at or before the sale; and
  - (d) keeps a copy of the document; and
  - (e) if asked to do so by an authorised officer or a member of the police force, produce for inspection any document the person has created under this clause that is in his or her possession.

**Authorisation to take or keep syngnathids**

6. A person may take or keep syngnathids provided that the person –
  - (a) does not take the syngnathids from Victorian waters; and
  - (b) obtains, on taking the syngnathids, a copy of a document from the seller which contains the following information –
    - (i) the name and address of seller;
    - (ii) the date of the sale;
    - (iii) the species of syngnathid;
    - (iv) the quantity of individual species of syngnathids sold;
    - (v) a unique identifying number generated from a sequential system of numbering the record of the sale; and

- (c) keeps a copy of the document; and
- (d) if asked to do so by an authorised officer or a member of the police force, produce for inspection any document the person has created under this clause that is in his or her possession.

Notes:

1. The **Fisheries Act 1995** defines “take” to mean gain possession or control by any means. It therefore includes buying protected aquatic biota.
2. A person may take syngnathids from Victorian waters if authorised to do so by a permit issued under section 72 of the **Fisheries Act 1995**.
3. This Order does not authorise a person to display for reward or release into Victorian waters syngnathids. Section 71 of the **Fisheries Act 1995** makes it an offence to display for reward or release into Victorian waters protected aquatic biota without a permit or unless authorised by an Order in Council under section 73 of the **Fisheries Act 1995**.
4. Section 120B of the **Fisheries Act 1995** requires that a document of the sort referred to under clause 5 or 6 of this Order must be kept for at least 3 years after its creation.
