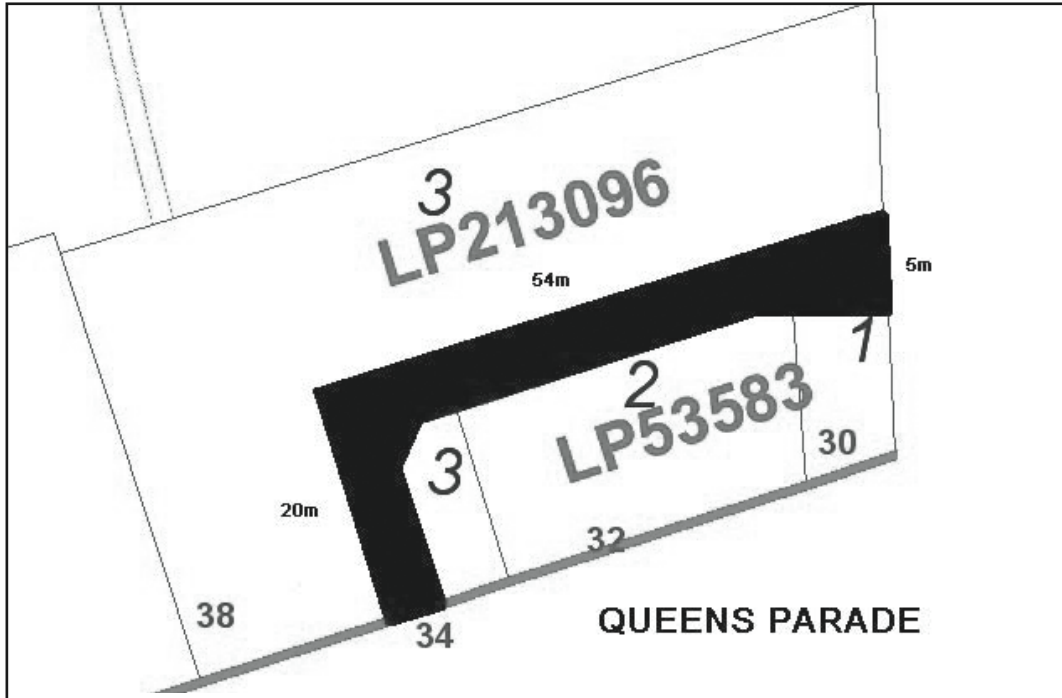

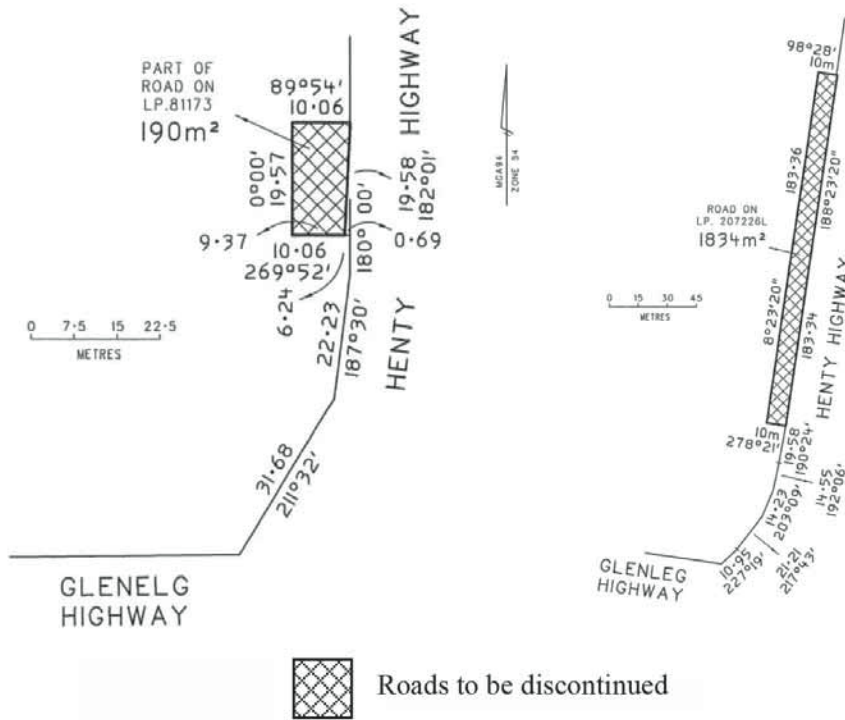

## Naming of Roads and Places Throughout Macedon Ranges Shire (Round 9)

I refer to the recent process of naming various roads and places throughout Macedon Ranges Shire.

Consultative processes were undertaken via advertisements in the local newspapers inviting comment/submissions on the naming of these roads. Various Authorities and nearby residents adjacent to the roads were also written to requesting feedback.

A number of submissions were received in response to this consultation process. A working group of Councillors has reviewed these submissions and made the following decisions.

Road	Name
Unnamed road off Gap Road, Riddles Creek.	To be named <b>Pear Lane</b> as suggested by one of the local residents as the property adjoining the road reserve was once a pear plantation.
Unnamed Government road off Cobb & Co. Road, Carlsrhue.	To be named <b>Farmer Road</b> . Early landowners of the area.
Unnamed Government road off Rutters Lane, between Three Chain Road and Carlsrhue Central Road, Carlsrhue.	To be named <b>Clerk Road</b> . Early landowners of the area.
Unnamed Government road off Salisbury Road, near Shepherds Hill Road, Lauriston.	To be named <b>Smithwick Road</b> . Early landowner of the area, former Shire Councillor, policeman, hotel owner and farmer.
Unnamed Government road off Fiddlers Green Road, Kyneton.	To be named <b>Old Station Road</b> . Close to old Redesdale Railway line and stations.

The necessary formal advertising/gazettal process will now be undertaken, relevant authorities notified and Council's records adjusted. Formal signage will also be installed shortly.

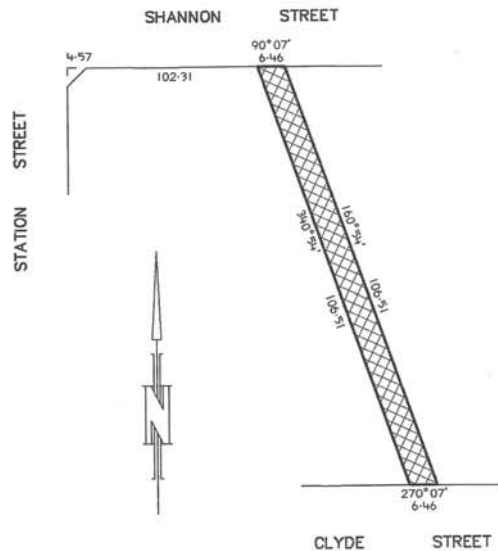

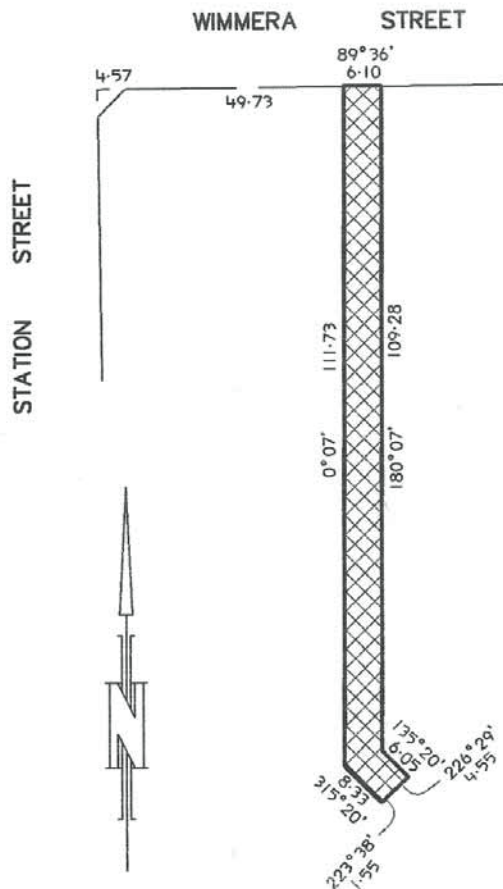
Road Discontinuance

Notice of Intention to Amend the Current Hours of the Winter Foreshore Dog Restrictions

Notice is given that at its meeting on 17 December 2007, Council resolved to give public notice of its intention to amend the current hours of the Winter Foreshore Dog Restrictions. The current winter restrictions allow dogs to be off leash in Section B of the foreshore precinct before 10 am and after 3 pm. The Section B defined area is between Plummer Road, Mentone and Bay Street Car Park, Mordialloc and between the eastern sides of Mordialloc Creek to Old Post Office Lane, Carrum. The winter restrictions are in place from 1 April to 31 October each year.

It is proposed to amend the hours to allow dogs off leash daily from sunrise until 11 am and from 3 pm to sunrise.

Any person may make a written submission regarding the proposed amended hours for the Winter Foreshore Restrictions within 28 days of this notice. Submissions will be considered

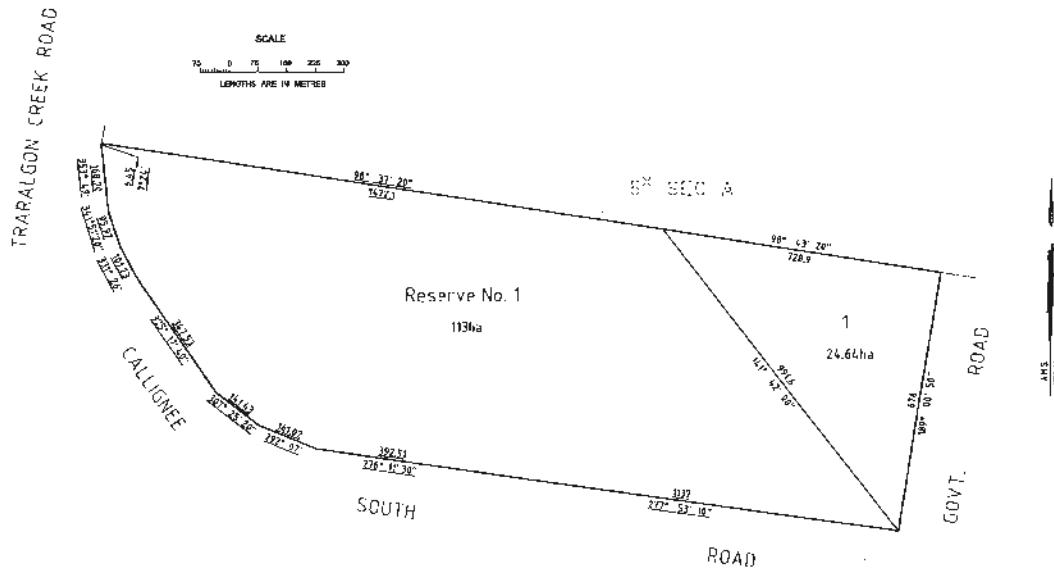

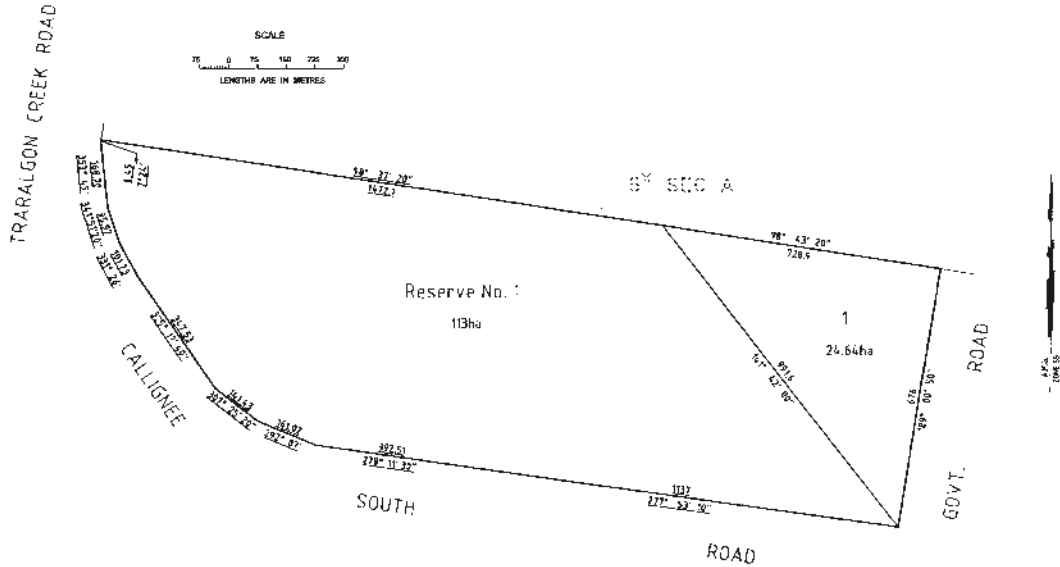

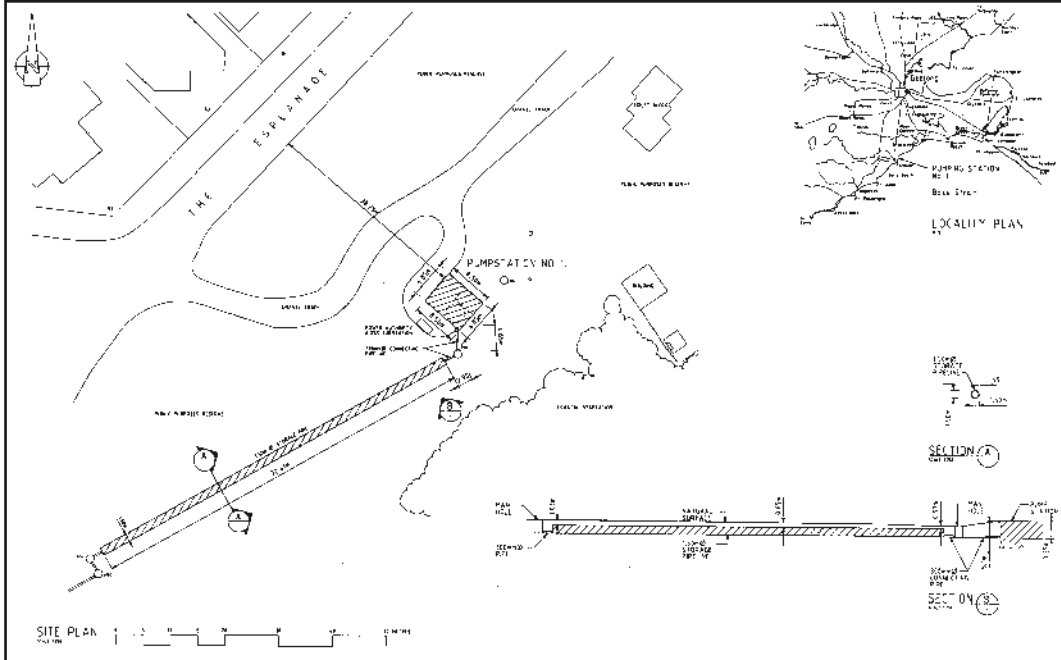
**ORDER GIVING APPROVAL TO GRANT OF A LEASE UNDER  
SECTIONS 17D AND 17DA**

Under sections 17D and 17DA of the **Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978**, I, Gavin Jennings MLC, Minister for Environment and Climate Change, being satisfied that there are special reasons which make the granting of a lease reasonable and appropriate in the particular circumstances and to do this will not be substantially detrimental to the use and enjoyment of any adjacent land reserved under the **Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978**, approve the granting of a lease to Barwon Region Water Corporation by the Great Ocean Road Coast Committee Incorporated as the Committee of Management, for a term of twenty one (21) years for the purpose of Sewerage Pumping Station, Emergency Sewerage Storage Pipeline and associated Inspection Pits and Pipelines over the area of Crown land being part of the Torquay Public Purposes Reserves described in the Schedule below and, in accordance with section 17D(3)(a) of the **Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978**, state that –

- (a) there are special reasons which make granting the lease reasonable and appropriate in the particular circumstances; and
- (b) to do this will not be substantially detrimental to the use and enjoyment of any adjacent land reserved under the **Crown Lands (Reserves) Act 1978**.
