SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Graeme York, Chief Executive Officer, International Power Hazelwood, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** of the following amendments to Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**:

1. the rules regulating the operation of vessels on the waters of Lake Hume set out in Schedule 95 of the Notice made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** are hereby revoked; and
2. give notice of the following rules regulating the operation of vessels on the waters of Hazelwood Pondage:

SCHEDULE 110

WATERS – HAZELWOOD COOLING POND

Waterway Manager – International Power Hazelwood

1. Areas prohibited to vessels for the purposes of Clause 9
The following waters of the Hazelwood Cooling Pond:
 - (a) Outlet pond, outlet channel and the outlet bank; and
 - (b) The inlet pond, inlet bank and inlet structure; and
 - (c) The waters in the southeast bay bound by a line extending from a beacon located on the shore in approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 51.8820''$ S $146^{\circ} 22' 59.5848''$ E to a beacon located on the southern shore in approximate position $38^{\circ} 18' 3.5064''$ S $146^{\circ} 22' 49.0800''$ E; and
 - (d) The waters bound by:
 - (i) a line extending from a marker located on the shore at approximate location $38^{\circ} 17' 46.2084''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 34.9992''$ E to a marker buoy located at approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 45.5964''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 36.9036''$ E;
 - (ii) a line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 45.5964''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 36.9036''$ E to a marker buoy located in approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 50.6256''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 37.2204''$ E;
 - (iii) a line extending from a marker buoy located in the approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 50.6256''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 37.2204''$ E to a marker located on the shore at approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 51.2376''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 35.3160''$ E; and
 - (iv) a line extending in an easterly direction from a marker located on the shore at approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 57.5664''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 29.7720''$ E to a marker located on the shore at approximate position $38^{\circ} 18' 5.7204''$ S, $146^{\circ} 22' 32.9772''$ E;are prohibited to vessels.

SPECIAL

2. Special Purpose Area for the purpose of Clause 13

The waters marked by yellow buoys and bound by:

- (a) a line extending westward from a beacon located on the eastern wall at approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 34.4580''$ S $146^{\circ} 23' 0.5892''$ E to a marker buoy located in the water at approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 19.9680''$ S $146^{\circ} 22' 14.8872''$ E;
- (b) a line extending from a marker buoy located in the approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 19.9680''$ S $146^{\circ} 22' 14.8872''$ E to a marker located on the island at approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 44.7936''$ S $146^{\circ} 21' 44.3304''$ E; and
- (c) A line extending from a marker located on the southern tip of the island, in the approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 42.9540''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 41.7996''$ E to a marker on the shore located in approximate position $38^{\circ} 17' 44.0304''$ S, $146^{\circ} 21' 37.1268''$ E;

are designated as a 5 knot zone for all vessels with engines, at all times when a red flag is displayed from the buoys.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that for the periods and locations outlined below, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the fireworks event are prohibited in an area with a 110 metre radius from a point approximately 110 metres north of the most northern arm of the jetty in the Royal Victorian Yacht Club in the waters of Hobsons Bay from 8.15 pm on 25 January 2008 until 9.45 pm on 25 January 2008.

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stuart Ord, Regional Manager, City and Bays, Parks Victoria, hereby:

- 1) revoke notice 287/2008 as published in Government Gazette G3 on 17 January 2008.
- 2) give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that for the periods and locations outlined below, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the 2008 Chinese New Year Dragon Boat Regatta are prohibited on the following waters of the Yarra River:
 - (a) The waters of Victoria Harbour within the area detailed in Table 1 from 8.00 am on 10 February 2008 until 5.30 pm on 10 February 2008.
