PROPOSED RADIATION AMENDMENT (TANNING UNITS AND FEES) REGULATIONS 2008

Preparation of Regulatory Impact Statement

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in connection with the proposed Radiation Amendment (Tanning Units and Fees) Regulations 2008.

The proposed regulations are to be made under section 139 of the **Radiation Act 2005**.

The objective of the proposed regulations is to:

- prescribe a commercial tanning unit to be a non-ionising radiation apparatus;
- prescribe fees;
- make provision for the waiver, reduction or refund of the application fee for a use licence.

The Regulatory Impact Statement assesses the costs and benefits of the proposed regulations and concludes that the benefits of the proposed regulations outweigh the likely costs.
