SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Stephen Duncan, Marine Officer, Hazelwood International Power Inc. hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that between the hours of 8.00 am and 3.00 pm on Saturday 18 October and 8.00 am and 1.00 pm on Sunday 19 October:

- (a) the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Victorian Open Water Swim, is prohibited on the waters of the Hazelwood Cooling Pondage in the area designated as a 'Special Purpose Area for the purpose of Clause 13' contained in Schedule 110 of Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
- (b) vessels involved in the Victorian Open Water Swim are excluded from Clause 3(a) of Notice No.1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
- (c) vessels involved in the Victorian Open Water Swim are excluded from Clause 1(d) contained in Schedule 110 of Notice No.1 made under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Chris Hardman, Manager of Operations, Bays and Maritime Division, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that from 7.30 pm on 18 October 2008 until 8.30 pm on 18 October 2008, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) excepting Parks Victoria vessels and those vessels involved in the presentation of the Dwali Festival fireworks display, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River between the upstream edge of the VRA Landing and the downstream edge of the VRA Landing.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Colin McQuillen, Business Support Officer, Southern Rural Water, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

- (a) between the hours of 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Saturday 18 October and 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Sunday 19 October 2008, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Glenmaggie and District Boat Racing Event, is prohibited on all the waters of Lake Glenmaggie north-west of an imaginary line between the water's edge at Coongulla Point and the water's edge at Cemetery Point.
- (b) between the hours of 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Saturday 18 October and 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Sunday 19 October 2008, vessels involved in the Glenmaggie and District Boat Racing Event are excluded from the requirements of Notice 264/2007 published in the Government Gazette No. S278, Friday 2 November 2007, on all the waters of Lake Glenmaggie north-west of an imaginary line between the water's edge at Coongulla Point and Cemetery Point.
- (c) between the hours of 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Saturday 18 October and 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Sunday 19 October 2008, vessels involved in the Glenmaggie and District Boat Racing Event are excluded from the requirements of Clause 3 of Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
