Marine Act 1988

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, the Director of Marine Safety, on the recommendation of Trevor Miles, Acting Manager of Operations, Bays and Marine Division, Parks Victoria, hereby give notice under subsection 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on Sunday 26 October 2008, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding those vessels involved with the Community Safety Day is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River as detailed in Table 1.

Table 1: Victoria Harbour Exclusion Zone for the purpose of the Community Safety Day

The waters bounded by:

- (i) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 1.42968" S, 144° 56' 42.0072" E to a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 3.734148" S, 144° 56' 43.0584" E;
- (ii) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 3.734148" S, 144° 56' 43.0584" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 4.220436" S, 144° 56' 33.7092" E;
- (iii) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 4.220436" S, 144° 56' 33.7092" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 6.366" S, 144° 56' 34.9548" E;
- (iv) A line extending from a marker buoy located in approximate position 37° 49' 6.366" S, 144° 56' 34.9548" E to a marker buoy in approximate position 37° 49' 1.42968" S, 144° 56' 42.0072" E.

- (a) vessels involved with the Community Safety Day are excluded from Clauses 2(a), 2(c), 3(a), 3(b), 7 and 12 of Notice No.1 made under s.15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on Sunday 26 October 2008.
- (b) all operators and occupants of vessels propelled by paddle or oar and operated by Lifesaving Victoria, and involved in the event, are exempt from PFD wearing requirements as specified in Regulation 232 provided supervision of participants and appropriate rescue services are provided.
- (c) At the completion of the event and as determined and announced by Parks Victoria, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No.1 made under subsection 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
